*An organisation does not choose sustainability, but acts on sustainability, no sustainability means no long term, no long term...no future!*

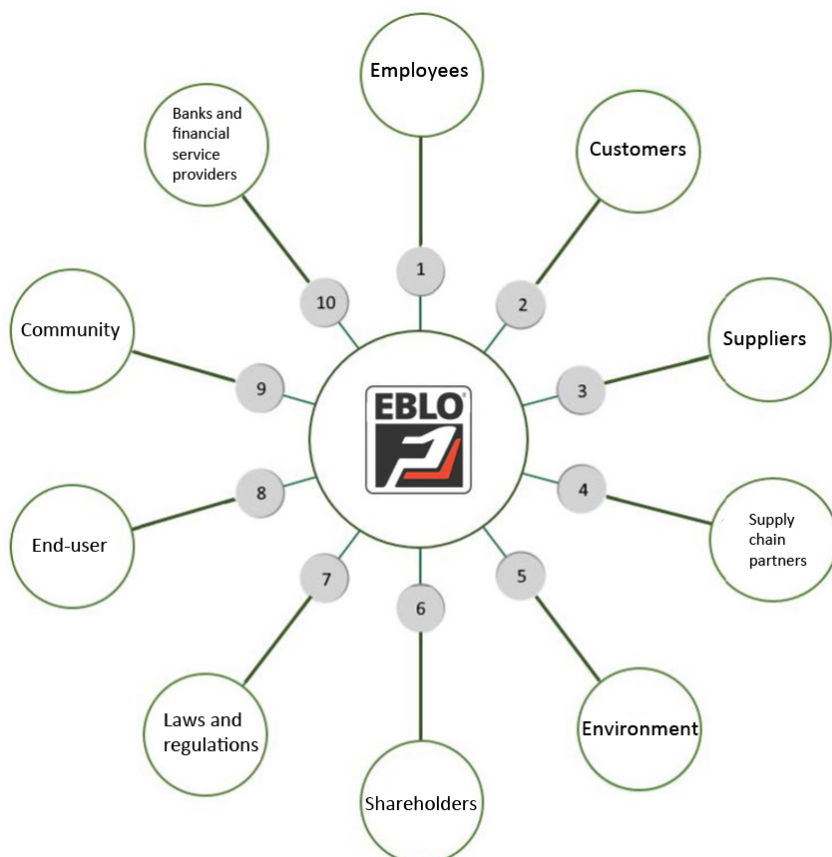
