# Opposition to motion for temporary orders in Texas

We're in this together. We're here to make the process as transparent as possible. Below you'll see the step by step process and what you can expect in terms of timeline.

Your service, explained in a sentence:

You're responding to a motion for a temporary order.

## What's included

- ✓ Preparing and filing paperwork needed
- ✓ 1 attempt to serve the paperwork to the opposing party in your case (if they're in the US and we know where to find them)
- ✓ Court filing fees
- ✓ Your attorney will go to 1 temporary order hearing with you
- ✓ If necessary, your attorney will draft and/or review the temporary order

### Please note

- This service only includes 1 court hearing. If you need another court hearing, you'll need to add an additional service.
- This service does not include mediation.

## The steps and timeline

The descriptions provided here are for illustrative purposes only. Please refer to your signed Marble Agreement to review the specific services you have agreed to. Your legal team will do its best to tackle your legal issue(s) as timely as possible, however, we make no guarantees as to how long your case will take. Every case is different, and several factors may impact the timeline of your case, including varying court processing times and suggested changes to your legal service offerings.

### 01 Talk to a lawyer about your needs

Once we understand your unique situation, we can recommend the right service for you.

### 02 Sign the Marble Agreement

This is our official agreement, with the services we'll do and the payment info.


### 03 Meet your legal team

First things first, you'll meet your attorney, get to know your legal team and go over your case strategy.

 **When will this happen?**  
Up to 3 days from signing the Marble Agreement

### 04 We need some information from you

To take care of your paperwork, we'll need some info and documents from you.

 **When will this happen?**  
It's up to you—we ask you to send it back to us as soon as possible

### 05 We prepare all the paperwork needed to file your response

 **How long does this take?**  
10 days once we have all your documents and information

### 06 Your paperwork is ready for your signature

 **How long does this take?**  
We ask you to review and sign within 2-3 days

### 07 We file the paperwork with the court

 **How long does this take?**  
2-3 days

### 08 The county clerk processes your paperwork

 **How long does this take?**  
It's up to the court but typically this takes about a week

### 09 We attend a court hearing

 **When does this happen?**  
The court date should be on the paperwork you were served with

### Please note

This service only includes 1 court hearing. If you need another court hearing, you'll need to add an additional service.

### 10 The court order is ready for review and signature

Typically, the opposing party prepares the court order. Once it's ready, you will need to review and sign.

 **How long does this take?**  
About a week

### 11 According to the Marble Agreement, we've completed our work.

We know this may not be the end of your legal journey, but you've already come this far. Take a moment to acknowledge this milestone.
