

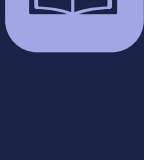

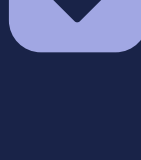

The judge was happy for her. It was a happy ending to a stressful case.
