Typing letters

Letters are the same as the braille alphabet

Typing contractions

Contractions work in the same way as UEB grade 1 braille

Space

Press 8

Backspace

Shift enter

Press 2 and 8

Numbers

Press 3,4,5,6 first to enable numbers. The numbers are the same as braille. To go back to typing alphabets, press button 8 for space and continue.

Capitals

Press 6 first, followed by the letter you want to type. The letter after that will automatically be lower case again.

Pressing 6 twice activates capitals for the next word. Adding a space deactivates the capitals. Pressing 6 three times will activate CapsLock for the coming sentence. An Enter will deactivate the capitals.

Hold 1, 2, 3 and 5 (r)

Set the duration of the "hold down time"

4 vibrations means you need to hold the buttons the longest, one vibration means the shortest.

Exchange button 1 with button 3 and button 4 with button 6
