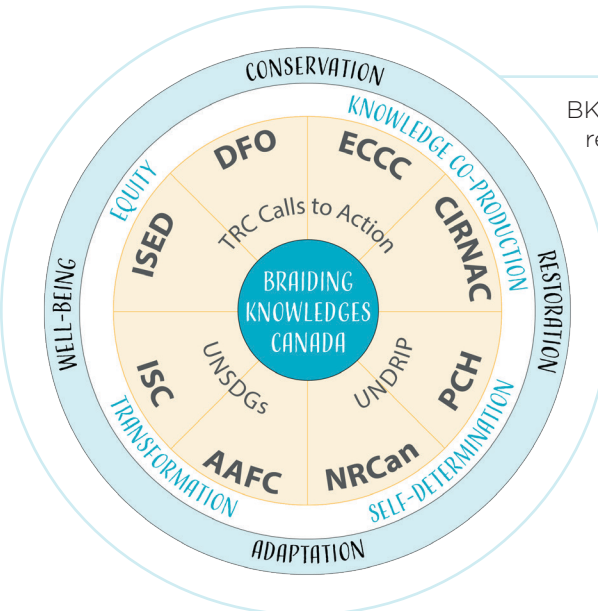


BRAIDING KNOWLEDGES CANADA RECONCILIATION THROUGH RESEARCH

1. STRATEGIC VALUE

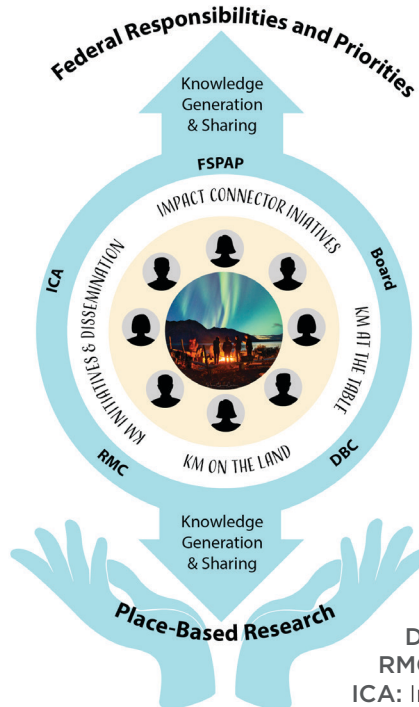
BKC aligns with priorities and responsibilities of federal departments and agencies, UN SDGs, UNDRIP, TRC, and 2021 ministerial mandate letters

Mobilizing knowledge between place-based research & federal responsibilities in a reciprocal manner

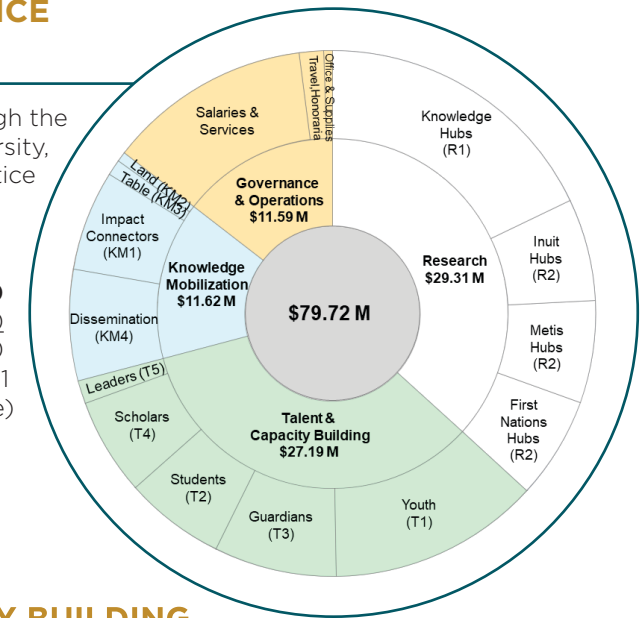

5. CULTURE, GOVERNANCE & MANAGEMENT

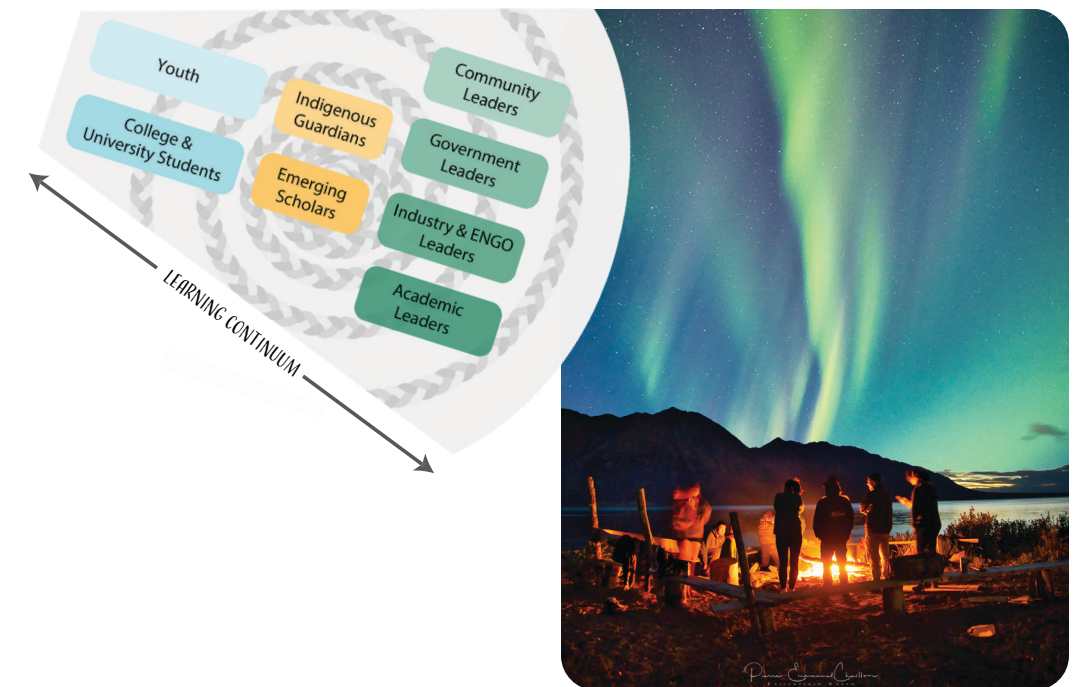
Transformation of culture through the braiding of knowledges, equity, diversity, inclusion & justice
