Music has been at the heart of Gloucester Cathedral and its community's life for almost 1,000 years. If music is at the heart of the Cathedral, then the organ is its heartbeat.

Rejoice & Revitalise

The Cathedral musicians are intrinsic to every service, celebration and season. Day-to-day life without them is unthinkable.

Our choirs are given the best training, not only in musicianship but in other valuable skills such as teamwork, self-discipline and confidence.

We are renowned for our choral excellence, with thousands of visitors from around the world coming to hear our musicians throughout the year.

As well as leading us in worship and other events, our musicians play a crucial role in the Cathedral's outreach work, impacting hundreds of families from across the county each year.

Over 500 families and children from diverse areas across the county take part in outreach activities led by our Music Department every year.

Refurbish & Renew

The organ itself is of huge historic significance: it was originally constructed in 1666 by Thomas Harris and represents the only complete 17th Century cathedral organ case in this country.

The need for a refurbishment of the organ comes roughly every 50-70 years, and it falls on our generation to secure it for the future. This need was emphasised by its premature failure in the Spring of 2022.

To bring the Cathedral organ back to life, we contracted pipe organ builders, Nicholson & Co Ltd, to refurbish and renew it. This work is vital to ensure the organ remains at the very heart of Cathedral music, so that it can continue to inspire, educate and captivate future musicians and audiences of the future.
