## Nasc Migrant and Refugee Rights Centre



Nasc's goal is to realise the rights of all migrants and refugees within Irish society. Nasc (the Irish word for 'link') empowers people to fulfil their rights, with the support of its free services.

By working with migrants and refugees to advocate and lead for change within Ireland's immigration and protection systems, the Nasc team seeks to ensure fairness, access to justice and protection of human rights.

## Nasc provides a wide range of services:

- It offers advocacy and legal information for over 1,200 people annually. The Advocacy service includes outreach to direct provision and emergency centres in Cork city and county. Nasc's Advocacy Service can help with questions about immigration status, family reunification, visas to Ireland, citizenship or your reception conditions if you are living in IPAS accommodation or looking to re-enter IPAS accommodation.
- The Women's Project at Nasc includes English language classes, and integration and

employment supports for women who have experienced forced displacement. Nasc's social work initiatives support children, young people and families, including unaccompanied minors and those aging out of care.

- The New Beginnings Children and Family project works with families newly reunited in Ireland, to provide social work and prevention of poverty supports.
- Nasc is involved in the innovative Community Sponsorship programme which supports local people in Ireland who wish to sponsor and welcome refugee families arriving under the resettlement programme.

Nasc also provides a Ukrainian - language information and advocacy service.


