- Complete calculations to size ductwork, piping, plumbing and drainage, and refrigerant lines.
- Prepare tender drawings, equipment schedules, and specifications.
- Co-ordinate the mechanical system layout with the architectural, structural, and electrical components of a building.
- Prepare project specific details / sketches to clarify project scope and assist with interference coordination between building systems.
- Respond to internal and external communication regarding project or design status.
- Liaise with equipment suppliers / manufacturers for design support, and equipment / component selection.
- Assist with construction administration by conducting site visits, reviewing shop drawing submittals, and preparing change notices, site instructions etc.
- Assist with site reviews, and snagging installations and witnessing system testing.
