## **Gnomon's Surrounding Neighborhoods**

Most students live within walking distance of Gnomon. There are many apartment buildings in the neighborhoods west and south of campus. We recommend people search for housing on Cole, Wilcox, Hudson, or Seward street, north of Melrose Ave.

Apartments are rented very quickly due to a high demand for housing, and not all building managers post apartment listings online. You may be more successful in finding housing near campus if you take some time to explore the surrounding neighborhoods prior to the start of the term.

## **Helpful Tips**

- Set a budget (include rent, utilities, internet, and transportation costs)
- Choose a neighborhood consider distance, parking, commute
- Read your lease thoroughly before signing
- Get Renter's Insurance
- Some rentals will require a co-signer

## Ask important questions about:

- Application, Deposit, Guest, Pet, and Parking Policies, Move-in, Lease Duration and Termination, Late Fees, Maintenance and Safety.
- Avoid (if possible) providing any personal information to anyone over the phone until you've spoken face-to-face to a landlord manager and have seen the listing in person.
- If you're not able to see a listing in person, see if there are virtual options – some apartment communities will offer tours via Facetime or Skype
- Create Roommate Agreements to establish clear expectations about chores, noise, and guests.

## **Temporary Housing & Hotels**

Individuals visiting campus for visits or short classes typically choose to stay in local hotels, or to use services such as Airbnb.

Hotel prices vary significantly, but we encourage those who plan to spend time on campus to stay in or around Hollywood due to traffic.

## Other Resources Near Campus

### **Parking**

Gnomon has parking available for students who plan to have a vehicle. Permits for the parking structure are \$140 per quarter (price subject to change). The structure is located one block south of campus, on the corner of Cahuenga and Romaine street. Permits are available for purchase in the student store after the start of each term. Visitors may park in the structure for free. Validation tickets are available at Gnomon's reception desk.

### **Transportation**

Students who do not drive and do not live within walking distance of campus typically rely on rideshare or public transportation. Uber and Lyft are popular choices in Los Angeles, with many students budgeting in some funds for safe rides to and from campus, especially for late night classes.

#### Food

There are two student kitchens on Gnomon's campus. Most individuals choose to bring food along with them for their class breaks. There are vending machines for snacks, drinks, and quick bites on site as well.

Because of Gnomon's location in Hollywood, there are many restaurants, coffee shops, and food stands within walking distance of campus. Students often walk off-site for food or coffee during class breaks. Additionally, a Pavilions grocery store is two blocks south of campus, which includes a sandwich counter, Panda Express takeout, a Starbucks, and more.

Just minutes from Gnomon, the <u>Hollywood Farmers' Market</u>, which is located on Ivar Avenue and Selma Avenue and is open every Sunday from 8:00am – 1:00pm, hosts 160 farmers, producers and food artisans who specialize in seasonal crops grown throughout California, offering a wide variety of culinary perspectives and practices from around the globe.

The Hollywood Farmers' Market is also a community meeting place with an eclectic range of activities and offerings that include live music, activities for children, a vibrant marketplace featuring handmade arts and crafts from local artisans, and book signings by some of the most celebrated authors in the food world.
