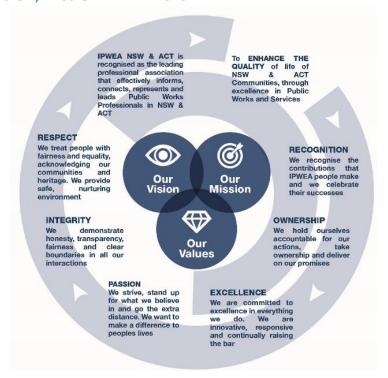


MINUTES 2023 ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

ITEM 1.0 PRESIDENTS WELCOME

ITEM 4.0 PRESENTATION OF REPORTS FROM OFFICERS

4.1 President's Report – The Report was tabled as part of the Annual Report.

The President highlighted a few key messages during the Annual General Meeting. The AGM brought the end of a Board term and the term had been difficult with floods, fires and natural disasters throughout the state.

The President outlined the previous CEO, Francine Binns, resigning and the incredible work Joshua Devitt did when he stepped up as acting CEO for six months. This calendar year has been very positive with the State Conference and Engineering Excellence Awards being held at Accor Stadium where members joned together to celebrate their work and experiences within local government.

The President also thanked the Board Directors for their counsel during the 2020-2023 term, especially Will Barton as Vice President and Peter Shields as fellow Australasian Board Director. The President also thanked the Municipal Engineering Foundation Trustees for their support throughout the term.

Finally, the President welcomed new Chief Executive Officer, the Honourable David Elliott, to the organisation and thanked him for his hard work since joining the Institute in May 2023.

4.2 Chief Executive Officer's Report

The Board election has been duly completed with two new Board Members elected, notably an increase in female representation.

After a high turnover of staff over the past 12 months, the team is now at a full complement with a new Sponsorship Manager, new Training Officer, new Cadet Engineer and new Finance Manager as well as a new CEO having all



started in the last six months. A slight restructure of duties has seen Josh Devitt become our first Chief Engineer and Laura Currie elevated to the role of Executive Officer to better reflect her responsibilities to the Board.

After a deficit in the last financial year the first quarter of 23/24 has been positive and with a solid Conference and growth in Professional Development, we hope to finish the year with a modest surplus

Regional Forums and Group Meetings have been merged in to "Chapter Meetings" with each region having at least two per year (Autumn and Spring). Our first event for 2024 "International Women's Day" luncheon will be held in Sydney on 8 March with the Transport Minister, Jo Haylen, secured as the Guest Speaker.

The Conference is booked for 10/11 April and judging for the Awards are currently underway. There have been 63 entries for the Awards. The theme for the conference is Country and Western and the theme of the business sessions is AI.

The Board has asked the Governor to officially open the conference and invited her to become our first Patron.

A review of the Institute's Consitution has also been independently undertaken and will be considered by the new Board in the new year although no significant changes are anticipated.

The main advocacy work been undertaken in the next 18 months will relate to the Government's commitment to Register Engineers in NSW

Also, the Foundation supports the Engineering Excellence Awards. This is particularly important to the Foundation as it promotes the good work in the sector and also recognising our peers.

Over the last twelve months the Foundation have identified some opportunities to improve the governance of the relationship and communication channels between the Foundation and the NSW and ACT Board. These improvements are underway and will be reporting on in the next Annual General Meeting.
