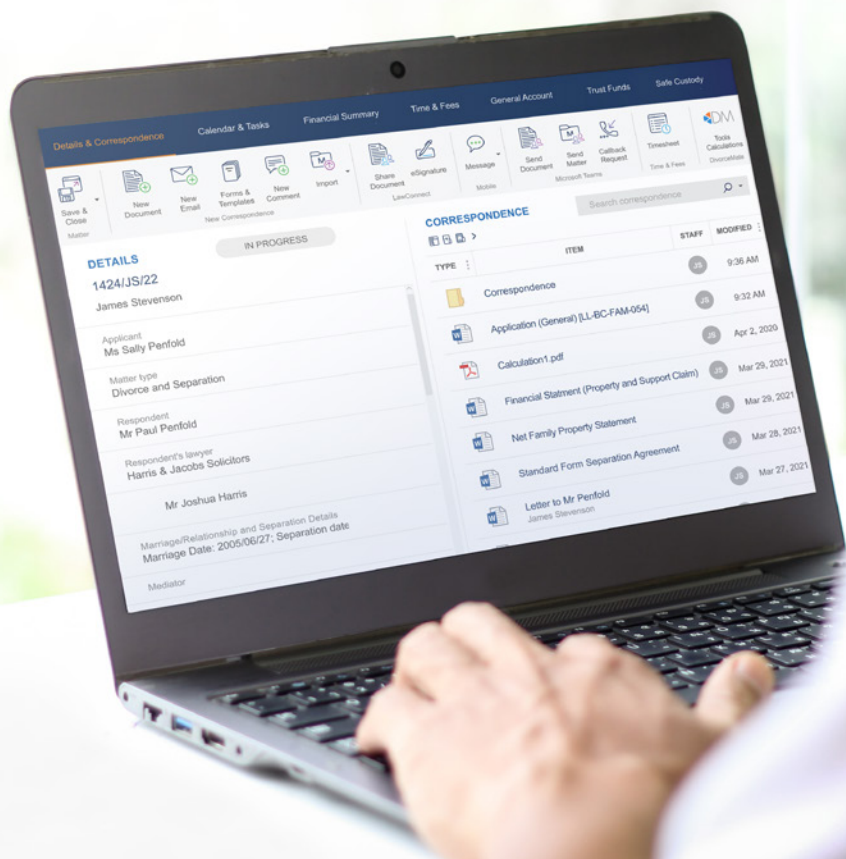
"With Child Support" Formula

The formula results in a range for spousal support of \$51 to \$930 per month for an indefinite (unspecified) duration, subject to variation and possibly review, with a minimum duration of 9 years and a maximum duration of 18 years from the date of separation.

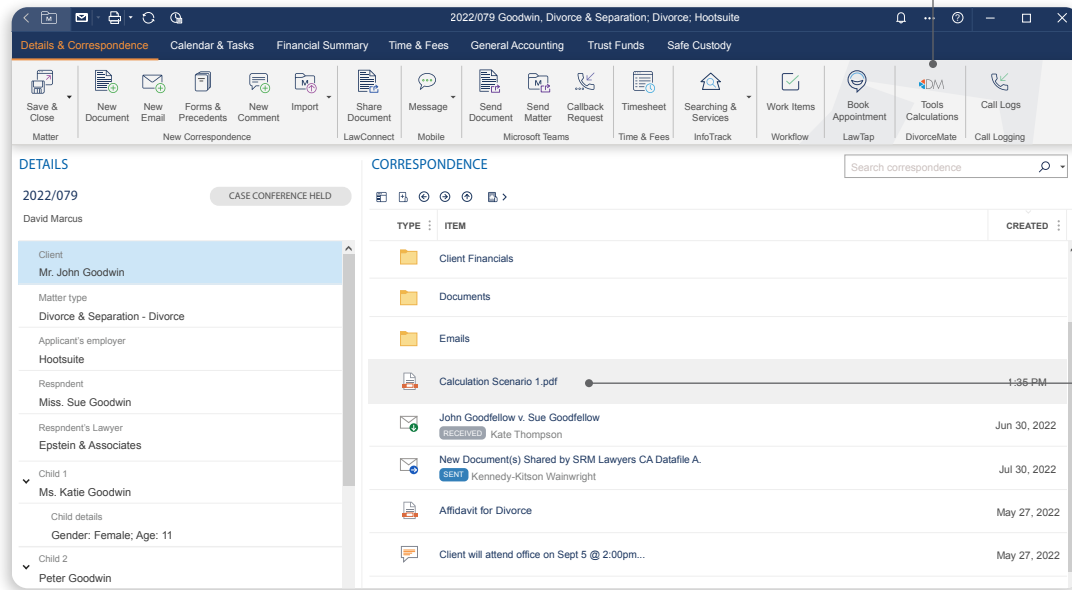

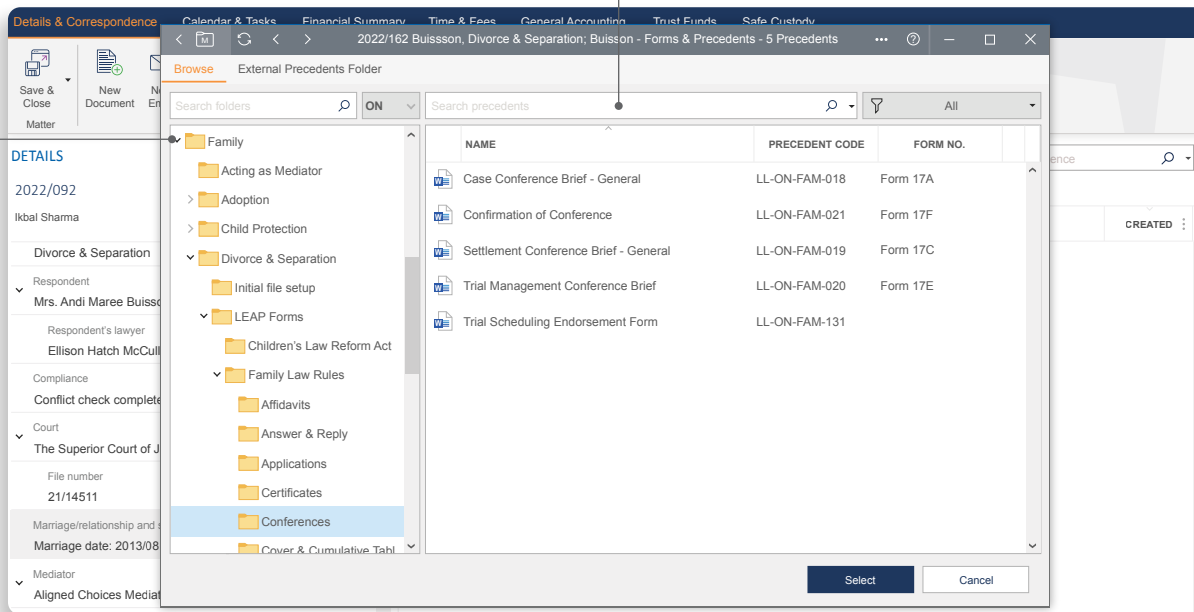
