TO: ALL HEALTH INSURANCE PLANS OFFERING MAJOR MEDICAL COVERAGE IN NEW MEXICO

RE: PROHIBITION ON COST-SHARING FOR TESTING AND HEALTH CARE SERVICES RELATED TO MONKEYPOX

On August 4, 2022, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services declared the monkeypox virus a public health emergency. Please see, https://www.hhs.gov/about/news/2022/08/04/biden-harris-administration-bolsters-monkeypox-response-hhs-secretary-becerradeclares-public-health-emergency.html.

Section 13.10.13.12 NMAC prohibits cost-sharing requirements related to testing or delivery of health care for any condition that is the subject of a declared public health emergency. No individuals shall be charged cost-sharing (coinsurance, deductible, or copayments) for testing or treatment related to monkeypox that is received during the declared the public health emergency.

Health plans and health insurance issuers shall reimburse any individuals who were erroneously charged cost-sharing for monkeypox since August 4, 2022. On-going violations of Section 13.10.13.12 NMAC shall be subject to enforcement actions to remedy those violations which include, but are not limited to, administrative penalties of up to \$10,000 per violation, and suspension of any certificate of authority or license issued under the insurance code.
