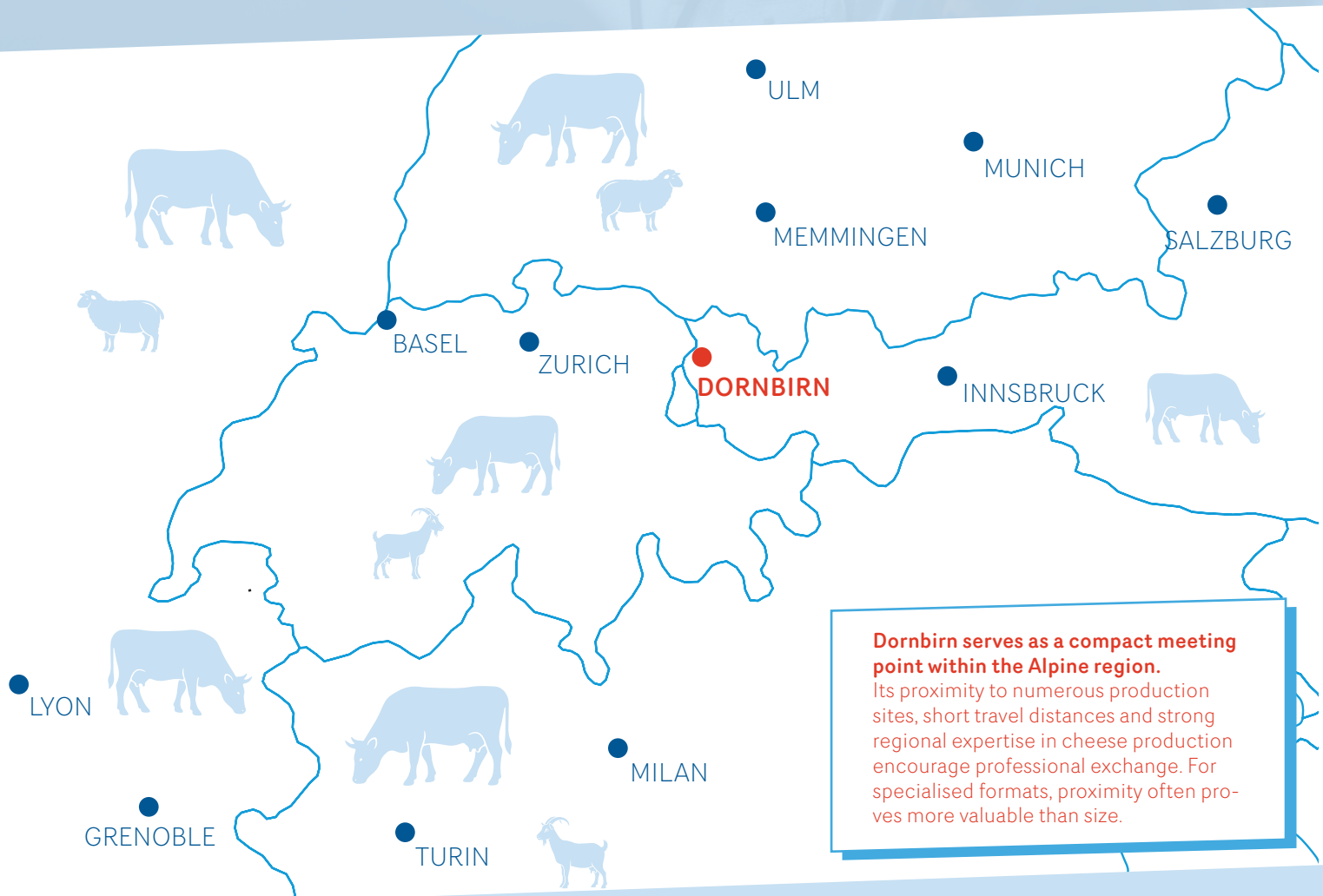

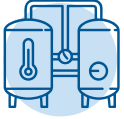


Over 8,000 dairy businesses, suppliers and specialised institutions are located within the service area, employing around 90,000 professionals.

The business case for MILCHWERK

Targeted access to relevant stakeholders

MILCHWERK addresses plant managers, as well as those responsible for production, engineering and quality assurance, along with technical procurement. Participation is deliberate and topic-driven. Discussions take place with individuals who lead, prepare or prioritise projects.

Structured interaction instead of chance encounters

MILCHWERK focuses on careful participant selection and content-led exchange. Two trade fair stages featuring expert forums, news cases and clearly defined discussion formats bring visitors and providers together in a targeted way.

Focus on concrete operational challenges

The programme addresses topics that many operations are currently tackling in parallel: energy and utilities, hygiene and food safety, automation, packaging, quality assurance, as well as refurbishment and expansion projects. The exchange links directly to ongoing or planned measures within the plant.
