

Address: Powerleague Nine Elms, 130 Thessaly Road.
Please use postcode SW8 4JS (St George Primary school which is opposite). Please do not use the postcode online as this will take you to New Covent Garden Market.

Tube: Powerleague is located almost opposite Battersea Power Station on the London Northern Line. The venue is a 5-minute walk from Battersea Park Station (overground)

Bus: Routes - 156, 344, 436

Car: There is NO parking available at the venue. Paid parking is available nearby.

Cycle: There is a Bicycle rack at the venue. It is lit and under CCTV surveillance 24/7.

- Each game is 12 minutes long
- Each team will be given vouchers for the BBQ. 1 per person. Please ensure these are not lost, there will be no replacements.
- 7 players must be used in any one game, 5 on the pitch and 2 rolling subs.
- The required footwear is AstroTurf trainers and molded boots; please note that no blades or metal studs are allowed.
- There are changing facilities and lockers at Powerleague. Please bring your own shower gels, towels ect.
- The pitches are approximately 25 metres x 16.5 metres. The goals are approximately 12 ft x 4 ft

Tournament Rules

HEAD HEIGHT

The ball cannot be played over head height. Powerleague have set an average benchmark of 6ft, however it is up to the discretion of the referee.



IN PLAY

The ball is active all the time. Play on if it rebounds off the side boards or goal.



PENALTY

Must be taken with a max of a one-step run up.



KICK OFF

You are allowed to shoot directly from Kick off.



FREE KICKS

Players must be stood 2 yards from the ball whether it's direct or indirect. Every incident resolved by free kick is indirect apart from a foul or handball.



FOUL PLAY

Players must not shout anything out in attempt to put off the opposition, this is deemed as unsportsmanlike behavior



TACKLES & HEADERS

Heading the ball or any form of slide tackles are not allowed and will result un a freer kick being awarded to the opposition.



STAY OUT OF THE BOX

If a member of the defending team goes inside the box to gain an advantage, a penalty will be awarded against them.



YOUR AREA

If the keeper comes out of the area at any point during the game, a penalty will be awarded to the opposing team. The keeper has only 6 seconds to release the ball.



STAY SHOULDER HEIGHT

The keeper can only distribute the ball with an underarm roll. Kicking the ball or over are throw will result in an indirect free kick awarded from the penalty spot.



NO PASS BACKS

The ball may not be returned to the goalkeeper by a player from his own team until played by a second player. This will result In an indirect free kick where the pass back occurred.

Referee Rules

A qualified affiliated referee will be supplied for all games - the referees' decision is final.



SENT OFF

If you are sent off, you will be off the pitch for the rest of the game without a substitute. If you are sin binned, you will be off the pitch for 2 minutes without a substitute.



VIOLENT CONDUCT

Violent conduct, including spitting at an opponent on or off the pitch will lead to immediate suspension for the duration of the game.



BANS

Powerleague 5's Ltd reserves the right to ban any individual or teams from all future participation in our leagues or tournaments.



FINAL DECISION

Swearing directly at the referee will result in a sending off. The referee's decision is final.
