

Terms & Conditions - RVRC Trail Leader Program

1. Background

RevolutionRace AB, org. no. 556938-2913, ("**RevolutionRace**", "**we**" or "**us**"), offers the RVRC Trail Leader Program (the "**Program**"). The Program is governed by and subject to these RVRC Trail Leader Program Terms and Conditions (the "**Terms**").

By submitting an application and completing the application process to the RVRC Trail Leader Program, you acknowledge and agree to be bound by the rules and requirements of the Program and RevolutionRace's brand values.

Before applying, you are required to carefully review all information relating to the Program, including these Terms and the Privacy Policy. Approval of your application is conditional upon completion of all required steps and the submission of complete and accurate documentation.

2. Qualifying criteria and approval procedure

Membership in the RVRC Trail Leader Program is granted for a limited period of twelve (12) months and may be renewed based on RevolutionRace's sole discretion. Renewal may require re-verification of eligibility and the submission of updated documentation, as determined by RevolutionRace. By applying for, registering as, accessing, using, or otherwise participating in the RVRC Trail Leader Program, you represent and warrant that you are at least 18 years of age. To apply to the Program, you must provide your name, work email address, name of the company/organization, role, address information, phone number, reason for applying to RVRC Trail Leader Program.

To be eligible to participate in the RVRC Trail Leader Program, you must fall within one of the professional categories supported by RevolutionRace under the Program. The professional categories of the RVRC Trail Leader Program are divided as follows:

2.1 Certified Outdoor Guides & Instructors: Licensed or otherwise certified outdoor guides and instructors, including but not limited to mountain guides, trek leaders, and rock-climbing instructors, as well as mountain biking or kayaking instructors holding relevant safety certifications, who are actively engaged in guiding or instructing multi-day trekking, ski touring, or wilderness expeditions.

2.2 Outdoor-Focused Fitness Coaches: Outdoor-focused fitness coaches specialising in training conducted in natural or outdoor environments, including but not limited to trail running and endurance training specialists, coaches delivering bootcamps or strength training in outdoor environments, and instructors integrating mobility, conditioning, and performance training for backcountry and outdoor sports, who are actively engaged in coaching or instructing in outdoor settings.

2.3 Adventure Sport Athletes: Athletes actively engaged in adventure and endurance-based outdoor sports, including but not limited to ski mountaineering, splitboarding, and backcountry snowboarding, as well as obstacle course racing (such as Spartan or Tough Mudder events), trail or ultra-distance running, and multi-sport adventure racing, who participate in such activities on a regular and ongoing basis.

2.4 First Responders: Individuals actively engaged in emergency response or rescue-related roles in outdoor or alpine environments, including but not limited to members of search and rescue (SAR) teams, wilderness first responders or avalanche safety educators, and firefighters, emergency medical technicians, or medics with experience in outdoor or alpine rescue operations.

3. Application process and review

As part of the application process, you are required to submit complete and accurate documentation to support your eligibility for the RVRC Trail Leader Program. Failure to provide the requested information may result in your application being rejected or delayed. Once your application and all

required documentation have been submitted, RevolutionRace will review your application and notify you of an approval or rejection within a reasonable period of time. Upon submission of your application, RevolutionRace will confirm receipt of the application by email.

All applications to the RevolutionRace Trail Leader Program are assessed on an individual basis, and approval of membership is at RevolutionRace's sole discretion. The eligibility criteria described in these Terms are indicative only and do not constitute an exhaustive list. RevolutionRace may, at its discretion, approve or reject any application, including applications that do not strictly meet the stated criteria.

4. General terms of the RVRC Trail Leader Program

4.1 Nature of the Program

Membership in the RVRC Trail Leader Program is granted at RevolutionRace's discretion and constitutes a voluntary benefit, not a right or entitlement. Participation in the Program does not establish any partnership, agency, employment, or other contractual or legal relationship between you and RevolutionRace beyond what is expressly set out in these Terms.

The Program may include different membership levels, with benefits varying between members as determined by RevolutionRace from time to time.

4.2 Use of program benefits

Program membership and any benefits provided under the RVRC Trail Leader Program, including discounted purchases, may only be used by the individual approved as a member, may not be shared, transferred, or used by any other person and shall be treated as confidential.

In the event of any dispute regarding the ownership or use of a Program membership, RevolutionRace will deem the membership to belong to the natural person associated with the email address used at the time of registration, as determined by the organisation or service provider responsible for assigning that email address.

4.3 Spending limits and monitoring

Membership in the RevolutionRace Trail Leader Program may be subject to spending limits, thresholds, or other usage restrictions, as determined and communicated by RevolutionRace from time to time.

RevolutionRace reserves the right to monitor and track purchases made using Program benefits in order to administer the Program and ensure compliance with these Terms.

4.4 Confidentiality and referrals

Members shall not publicly disclose, distribute, or promote Program benefits to individuals who are not eligible for or approved under the Program. Individuals who are not eligible for the Program and express interest in RevolutionRace products should be referred to RevolutionRace's official website or other authorised sales channels. Individuals who may be eligible for the Program may be referred to the Program application page to submit an individual application for review.

4.5 Prohibition on resale and gifting

Resale, transfer, or gifting of products purchased using benefits from the RVRC Trail Leader Program is strictly prohibited, unless expressly authorised by RevolutionRace in writing. Any breach of this restriction may result in the immediate termination of your Program membership, without notice.

4.6 Abuse, misuse and enforcement

Any abuse or misuse of the RVRC Trail Leader Program, including but not limited to failure to comply with these Terms, unauthorised resale, transfer or attempted resale of Program benefits, excessive or abnormal returns, fraud, misrepresentation, or any conduct that is inconsistent with RevolutionRace's brand values or may reasonably be considered harmful to RevolutionRace's reputation or brand, or any other improper conduct in connection with the Program, may result in the immediate termination of your Program membership.

In the event of abuse or misuse, RevolutionRace may also cancel any previously issued but unused Program benefits and disqualify the individual from future participation in the Program. RevolutionRace reserves the right to take appropriate legal or administrative action in response to abuse, to the extent permitted by applicable law.

4.7 Cancellation

You may cancel your membership in the RVRC Trail Leader Program at any time by contacting RevolutionRace using the contact details provided for the Program. Upon cancellation, your Program membership and associated account will be terminated and access to Program benefits will cease with immediate effect.

RevolutionRace may terminate your membership at any time at its discretion, including where RevolutionRace reasonably determines that continued membership is not consistent with the purpose of the Program.

4.8 Events outside our control

RevolutionRace shall not be liable for any delay, disruption, or failure in the operation of the RVRC Trail Leader Program resulting from circumstances beyond RevolutionRace's control. Where the Program is materially affected by such circumstances, RevolutionRace may take reasonable measures to inform members and to limit the impact on the Program, where possible.

4.9 Limitation of responsibility

RevolutionRace is liable only for loss or damage directly caused by RevolutionRace's wilful misconduct or negligence in connection with the RVRC Trail Leader Program. RevolutionRace shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, consequential, or economic loss, nor for any loss or damage arising from your participation in the Program, your professional activities, or your use of any products, services, or benefits provided under the Program, except to the extent such limitation is not permitted under applicable mandatory law.

4.10 Responsibility for third-party claims

You are responsible for any claims brought by third parties that arise directly from your breach of these Terms, your unlawful conduct, or content or information submitted by you in connection with the RVRC Trail Leader Program. To the extent permitted by applicable mandatory law, you agree to compensate RevolutionRace for direct losses incurred as a result of such claims.

4.11 Changes to the Program and the Terms

RevolutionRace reserves the right to amend, modify, or update the RVRC Trail Leader Program and these Terms from time to time for legitimate business, legal, or operational reasons. Any changes will be made available through the Program or otherwise communicated by RevolutionRace. Continued participation in the Program following the effective date of any changes constitutes acceptance of the revised Terms.

4.12 Governing law and jurisdiction

These Terms, the RVRC Trail Leader Program, and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with the Program or these Terms shall be governed by Swedish law. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with the Program or these Terms shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Swedish courts.

4.13 Severability

If any provision of these Terms is held to be invalid, unlawful, or unenforceable under applicable law, such provision shall be deemed severed and shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining provisions.

5. How to make a purchase as a member of the RVRC Trail Leader Program

5.1 Program benefits

As a member of the RVRC Trail Leader Program, you may be eligible for discounts or other purchase benefits made available by RevolutionRace from time to time. Information regarding available Program benefits, eligibility, and any applicable conditions will be communicated to you upon approval of your membership and through subsequent communications.

Program benefits may be made available on a periodic basis during your membership period, subject to these Terms and any additional conditions communicated by RevolutionRace.

5.2 Eligible purchases and exclusions

Program benefits may apply only to selected products, product categories, or collections. Any applicable exclusions will be determined by RevolutionRace and communicated in connection with the relevant Program benefit. Program benefits cannot be applied retroactively to purchases made prior to the activation of such benefits.

RevolutionRace reserves the right to add, remove, or modify eligible or excluded products, as well as the manner in which Program benefits are applied, at any time in accordance with these Terms.

5.3 How to use Program benefits

Program benefits may be available for online purchases only and must be redeemed using a unique code, as communicated by RevolutionRace.

Returns of products purchased using Program benefits shall be handled in accordance with RevolutionRace's general terms and conditions. All purchases made using Program benefits are subject to RevolutionRace's general terms and conditions, as applicable at the time of purchase.

6. Data protection

Personal data is processed for the purposes of administering and managing the Program, including evaluating applications, verifying eligibility, managing membership, and providing Program-related benefits. RevolutionRace may therefore process personal data relating to you, including your name, contact details, employer/business/organisation details, application information, eligibility documentation, and information relating to your membership status and use of Program benefits.

Such processing is based on RevolutionRace's legitimate interest in administering the Program and providing its benefits. Without this information, RevolutionRace cannot process your application or provide membership in the Program.

Personal data will be retained for the duration of the application process and, if approved, for the duration of the membership, and for up to 36 months thereafter for Program administration, handling of inquiries, and monitoring and prevention of misuse.
