HOW TO GET TO THE VENUE

Davos is located in the canton of Graubünden. Take the A3 motorway (Zurich – Chur) and exit at Landquart. Then continue via Prättigau, known for the legendary mountain bike marathon "Swiss Bike Masters," and Klosters to Davos.

The start and finish area is at the valley station of the Jakobshorn cable car. Please follow the signage from the town entrance.

Parking spaces are available at the Silvretta parking garage, Sports Center parking lot, Congress parking lot, Arkaden parking garage, Parsenn parking lot, Davosersee parking lot, and Sygmond parking garage.

The prize money will be consolidated and paid out via bank transfer after the final race in 2026.

Foreign riders are subject to withholding tax, which will be deducted directly from the prize money.

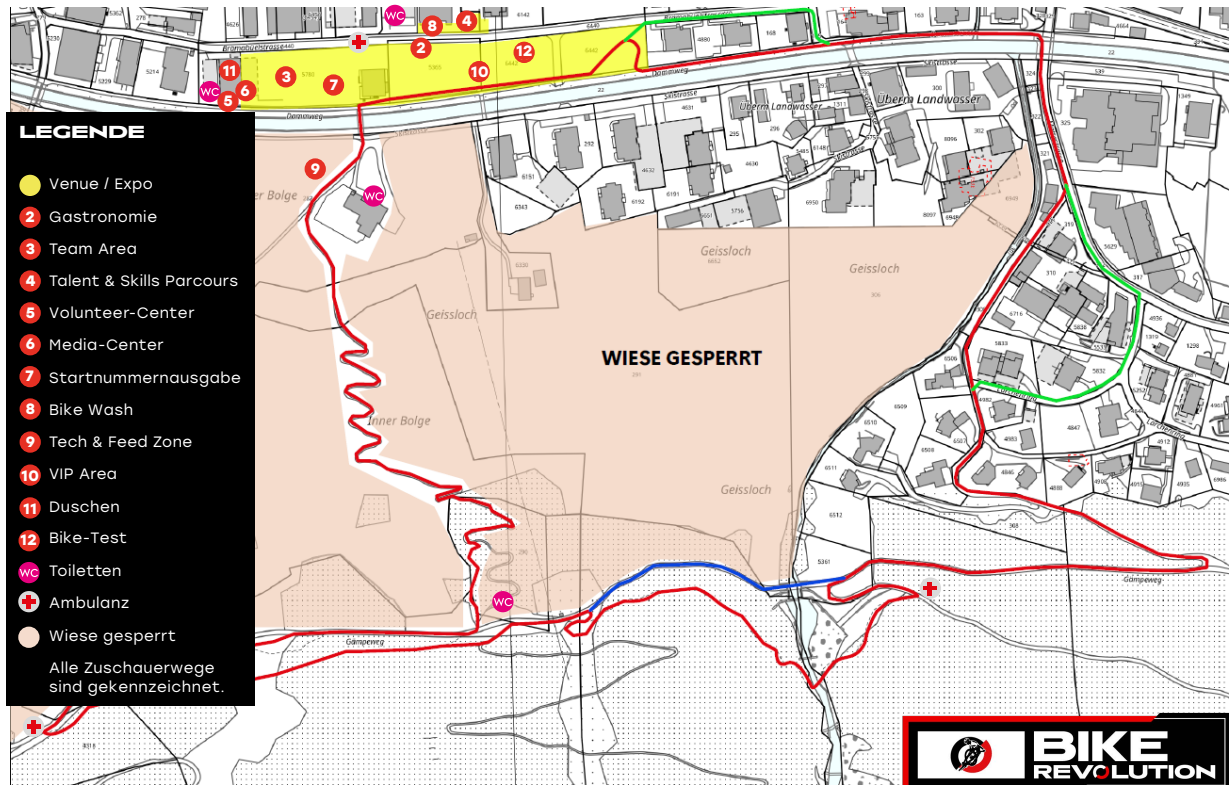
