

AcryBright™ TEN-YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

Effective Date: November 18, 2020

Aristech Surfaces LLC ("Aristech") warrants for a period of 10 years from the date of manufacture that each sheet of AcryBright™ will be free from manufacturing defects and that:

- the light transmission rate of each sheet will not decrease by more than 30% from the light transmission value recorded at the time of manufacture measured by spectrophotometer using a light source at a wavelength of 520nm;
- the modulus of elasticity of each sheet will not decrease by more than 30% from the value recorded at the time of manufacture:
- the flexural strength of each sheet will not decrease by more than 30% from the value recorded at the time of manufacture; and,
- each sheet with not exceed a Delta b yellowness index rating of 7 from the value recorded at the time of manufacture.

This Limited Warranty does not cover any defects, material failure or damage caused by or resulting from:

- 1. faulty design of, manufacture or installation into a third-party product;
- 2. exposure to methods used to join, attach, or seal AcryBright™, which have a detrimental effect on AcryBright™ (including where it has been used in a third-party product);
- 3. failure to clean AcryBright™ in accordance with Aristech's recommendations;
- 4. thermal alteration, forming or molding after manufacture;
- 5. transport, handling, storage or installation;
- 6. exposure to chemical agents, fumes, liquids or solids or acidic rain;
- 7. failure to replace worn or corroded third-party fasteners or attachments;
- 8. use of abrasive or aggressive solutions, materials or exposure to chemical agents; and,
- 9. the application of additional treatments, varnishes, paints, sealants or other systems or finishing products.

In addition, this Limited Warranty does not cover removal, (re)installation or fabrication costs and expenses or any other direct or indirect losses which may result from the failure.

Like all plastics, AcryBright[™] should be cleaned regularly and Aristech recommends a cleaning schedule of at least once per year. A regular cleaning program will reduce the effects of weathering but will not entirely eliminate weathering as weathering is normal. The current cleaning recommendations are:

- 1. Rinse sheet with lukewarm water ONLY. DO NOT ADD DETERGENTS OR SOAP to the water or apply detergents or soap directly to the surface as these may damage the surface.
- 2. Use a damp, soft cloth or sponge, lightly wash to loosen any dirt or residue. DO NOT SCRUB or use brushes or other abrasive cleaning pads. AcryBright™ clear acrylic sheet/block is not scratch or abrasion resistant.
- 3. Rinse with clean lukewarm water and dry with a soft clean cloth to prevent water spotting. Aristech's cleaning recommendations may be amended and updated from time to time and the most up to date information and recommendations are available on Aristech's website.

If any sheet of AcryBright™ shows a manufacturing defect or change in UV performance in excess of the warranted specifications above, Aristech will, at its option and sole discretion, either provide a replacement sheet of AcryBright™ in a quantity which is sufficient to replace the defective material; provide an equivalent Aristech product in a quantity which is sufficient to replace the defective material; or pay the cost of repairing the defective material.

For coverage under this Limited Warranty, you must register on line at www.aristechsurfaces.com within 30-days from the date of purchase or installation, whichever is later. Aristech will assign a warranty registration number. To obtain service under this Limited Warranty, write to the dealer/contractor from whom you purchased the product or alternatively write to Aristech at the address below providing your name and address, a description of the product involved, and the nature of the defect or failure. Refund or replacement shall not

include any labor charges. A warranty registration number, purchase receipt or other acceptable proof of purchase will be required before any warranty claim can be considered.

Aristech reserves the right to undertake independent investigations into the cause of any alleged defect or failure of AcryBright™. Determination of UV performance will be determined as follows: (i) Loss of Light Transmission and Yellowness levels will be measured in reference to DIN 5036 using a light source at a wavelength of 520nm from a clean, unscratched sample; and (ii) Flexural Strength and Modulus of Elasticity will be measured with reference to ISO 178. Samples will be conditioned to 23C/50% RH. Prior to the shipment of replacement material, the defective stock of substrate must be returned to Aristech for assessment.

ARISTECH may ship (freight collect) to you products replaced under this Limited Warranty.

THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, AND ARISTECH EXPRESSLY DISCLAIMS ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE (EVEN IF THE PURPOSE IS KNOWN TO ARISTECH), OR FROM COURSE OF DEALING OR TRADE USAGE. THIS LIMITED WARRANTY SETS FORTH YOUR SOLE REMEDY IN CONNECTION WITH THE SALE OR USE OF PRODUCTS COVERED BY THIS LIMITED WARRANTY AND IN NO EVENT SHALL ARISTECH BE OTHERWISE LIABLE FOR ANY LOSS, DAMAGE OR INJURY OF ANY NATURE ARISING OUT OF THE SALE OR USE OF THE PRODUCTS DELIVERED HEREUNDER, WHETHER FOR NEGLIGENCE, BREACH OF CONTRACT OR UNDER ANY OTHER LEGAL OR EQUITABLE THEORY. THIS WARRANTY IS NON-TRANSFERABLE. ARISTECH ASSUMES NO LIABILITY FOR IMPROPER FABRICATION AND/OR INSTALLATION.

Exclusive jurisdiction for legal disputes relating to alleged breach of warranty or representation of any nature must be filed in either the state or federal courts located in Boone County, Kentucky. Kentucky law will govern all disputes or claims arising out of the sale, purchase or use of the solid surface products.
