STEP ONE: Determine proper bracket placement

- Locate support rails on the underside of the van were the brackets need to be placed. Starting at the back near the leaf spring perch will be the first hole. Moving towards the front use the following. Driver side use holes #1, #2, #4 and #5. Passenger side use holes #1, #4, #5 and #6.
- 2. Place 2" bolt plates in rear smaller holes (2) each side Fig A & B. Place 3.5" bolt plates in front large oval holes (2) each side Fig C & D. Acquire brackets front, middle and rear use Fig G to help determine correct bracket. Mount each bracket as shown Fig G using installed bolt plate with 5/16" flange nuts hand tight, be sure to install top of bracket in second hole from tip as shown Fig E & F. Brackets in Fig F should be centered in oval hole. Attach a strap to each bracket using 5/16 bolt & nut Fig H & I.
- 3. Slide 5/16" * 3/4" bolts down outer channels on underside of boards, so (2) bolts are located at each bracket location. Place boards on brackets with bolts dropping through slots in brackets and secure with 5/16" flange nut to board hand tight.
- 4. Fully tighten top of brackets to support rails on vehicle. Board at this point should be close to its final installed location. Center board on vehicle to your preference.
- Now apply slight pressure up or down to make board level at each bracket location and use (2) self taping tek screws to attach straps to inside rocker panel Fig H. Only (1) self tapping screw required for mounting rear strap to vehicle channel Fig I.

STEP TWO: Board Installation Check.

 IMPORTANT: Check all bolts to verify completed mounting and tightness. Installation is complete
