I. Introductions

Committee members introduced themselves and stated their position on the committee. All visitors introduced themselves and stated the name of the organization they represented.

II. New Business

A. Approval of Public Minutes

Motion to approve minutes of the October 27, 2022 meeting by Larry Broussard and duly seconded by Yolanda Bennett. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

B Rules and Regulations Review and Update

Motion by Beverly Ogden to accept rules revisions and submit them to LSBME for consideration at the January meeting. Duly seconded by Angela Foley. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Attorneys will review revisions and determine what changes need to be made to the law for compatibility with the rules and draft a bill. LSBME will review the proposed rule revisions and proposed bill with changes to the law. If approved by the Board, they will solicit a legislator to sponsor the bill.

C. Pathology Assistants

Pathology assistants requested they be licensed under the CLP Licensure Law. Beverly Ogden will survey the pathology community on their willingness to support the PAs in this effort. She will also gather information on how other states are dealing with this issue and report back to the committee at the next meeting.

D. CEU Contract Proposal

Mary Peyton presented the LSUHSC Department of Medical Laboratory Science CEU proposal for 2023 to the committee. Motion by Michele Werner that the committee recommend the contract to the LSBME. Duly seconded by Nadlyn Rideaux. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Discussion on bidding process followed. If an entity is already on state contract, no bid is necessary. They can submit their proposal for consideration by the committee and the LSBME. If an entity is not on state contract, they must go through the bidding process to submit a CEU proposal. It was noted by Dr. Culotta that the bid process is lengthy and should be initiated early in 2023 for a 2024 contract.
