- * As a by-product of these contacts and direct staff-to-student coaching, many students engage in formal internships annually
- * A total of 778 students participated in experiential opportunities in FY19-20

AFA offers leader development programs that enhance college students' and young professionals' ability to accelerate their role as leaders in the agriculture industry.

- * The AFA Leaders Conference is a four-day, four-track experience where students gain tools and information to activate their role as a leader on campus and in the agriculture industry
- * AFA selects and provides training and exposure for student leaders including Student Advisory Team and Campus Ambassadors that plan and host AFA programs
- * AFA Alliance programs and membership for young professionals, including the annual Alliance Forum and Regional Seminars, provide industry information and continued professional development to those in their first decade of employment
- * Approximately 1267 students engaged in AFA Leader Development Programs in FY19-20
