1 Installation de PrestaShop sur Debian 11

1.1 Prérequis :

Avoir les droits root

Peut être obtenu via la commande suivante : `sudo su -`

Mettre à jour le système

```
apt update && apt full-upgrade -y
```

1.2 Installation du serveur LAMP

```
apt install apache2 mariadb-server
```

Activer le module rewrite d'apache2

```
a2enmod rewrite
```

```
systemctl restart apache2
```

Ajout du dépôt PHP 8.1

```
apt install software-properties-common apt-transport-https curl -y
```

```
curl -sSL https://packages.sury.org/php/README.txt | bash -x
```

```
apt update && apt upgrade -y
```

Installation de PHP 8.1 en plus des extensions requises par PrestaShop

```
apt install php8.1
```

```
apt install php8.1-simplexml php8.1-zip php8.1-curl php8.1-gd php8.1-pdo php8.1-intl php8.1-mysql  
php8.1-mbstring
```

```
systemctl reload apache2
```

1.3 Création de la BDD

```
mariadb-secure-installation
```

Répondre aux questions :

```
unix_socket → n
```

```
Définit le mdp root de mariadb → y
```

```
Remove anonymous user → y
```

```
Disallow root login → y
```

```
Remove test database → y
```

Entrer dans la console mariadb

```
mariadb
```

Créer la BDD

```
create database prestashop;
```

```
create user prestashopuser@localhost identified by 'p';
```

```
grant all privileges on prestashop.* to prestashopuser@localhost;
```

```
flush privileges;
```

```
exit
```

1.4 Installation de PrestaShop

Télécharger PrestaShop

```
cd /tmp
```

```
wget https://github.com/PrestaShop/PrestaShop/releases/download/8.1/prestashop_8.1.zip
```

Télécharger unzip afin de dézipper l'archive

```
apt install unzip
```

```
unzipprestashop_8.1.zip
```

Copier PrestaShop dans le répertoire d'apache2

```
cp prestashop.zip /var/www/html/
```

```
cd /var/www/html/
```

```
rm index.html
```

```
unzip prestashop.zip
```

Donner les droits sur les fichiers de PrestaShop à l'utilisateur d'apache2

```
chown www-data:www-data /var/www/html/ -R
```

```
chmod 775 -R /var/www/html/
```

```

Renommer le chemin du panel d'administration

```
mv /var/www/html/admin /var/www/html/dashboard
```

Recharger apache2

```
sudo systemctl reload apache2
```
