TWE Responsible Procurement Code

Treasury Wine Estates (TWE) is committed to maintaining the highest ethical, social, and environmental standards across our entire supply chain. As part of this commitment, all new and existing suppliers are expected to understand, follow, and demonstrate ongoing compliance with our Responsible Procurement Code (RPC). This Code sets clear expectations around respecting human rights, maintaining safe and fair working conditions, prohibiting forced or child labour, preventing discrimination, and ensuring freedom of association. It also outlines our requirements for ethical employment practices, rigorous health and safety





standards, proactive environmental stewardship, and strong governance measures to prevent bribery, corruption, and other forms of misconduct.

The RPC also requires suppliers to participate in due diligence processes during onboarding, and we may require you to reconfirm your continued compliance to the Code annually. All suppliers must be prepared to track and report on sustainability impacts, cooperate with TWE in managing risks such as modern slavery, and ensure that subcontractors and homeworkers meet the same standards. Regular monitoring, reviews, and audits form part of our approach, with an emphasis on continuous improvement.
