

Headway's Book Lovers Scholarship Terms and Conditions

Headway's Book Lovers Scholarship (the "**Scholarship**") seeks to empower ambitious students to achieve more through access to postsecondary education. The awards are offered to eligible students in the United States, the United Kingdom, Canada, and Australia for study at colleges, universities, and vocational-technical schools located in any of those four countries.

The program is run by Mobisol Limited (the "**Company**", "**we**", "**us**"). Direct all questions to us at scholarship@makeheadway.com.

Before beginning the application process and to better understand the Scholarship program, please read the following guidelines and instructions. Print or save this information and keep it on file for reference of program procedures and important dates.

Purpose of the Scholarship

The purpose of the Scholarship payment is to support the recipient's education. The Company does not track or verify how the funds are spent after payment is made.

Scholarship eligibility

Students are eligible to apply for the Scholarship provided that they:

- are a citizen or lawful resident of the United States, the United Kingdom, Canada, or Australia;
- are at least 16 years old;
- are in their final year of high school, secondary school, (upper) secondary school graduates, current college/university undergraduates, or graduate students;
- have a high-school cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (or the local equivalent in the applicant's country of education);
- demonstrate leadership at school and/or in the community; and
- will be enrolled in full-time undergraduate or graduate study at an accredited college, university, or vocational-technical school located in the United States, the United Kingdom, Canada, or Australia for the entire academic year in which the Scholarship is awarded.

The Scholarship is non-renewable. A total of 1 (one) scholarship will be awarded each year.

How to apply

You, the student, are responsible for gathering and submitting all required information. This is a competitive program. Your application is evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all applicable questions as completely as possible.

Our annual Scholarship cycle opens each year on April 15, and applications will be accepted until 3:00 p.m. Central Standard Time on September 15. Applications must be submitted through the Google Form linked on the scholarship page at <https://makeheadway.com/scholarship/>.

As part of the application process, you will be asked to submit the following:

1. **Information about you:**

- full name, address, and phone number.

2. **Paragraph about leadership:** Demonstrated leadership (e.g., activities, awards, and honors).

3. **Paragraph about your goals and motivation:** Information about the post-secondary school you plan to attend and your educational and career goals.

4. **A current, complete transcript of grades** (academic record). Transcripts must display the student's name, the school's name, grades, and credit hours for each course and term in which each course was taken.

- Students in their final year of high school/secondary school and students who have not completed a full year of college/university must send copies of their official final grades/marks from the past three or four years of (upper) secondary school and copies of their end-of-year exam results, if applicable; or
- Students who have completed one full year or more of college/university-level courses should send a copy of their official college/university academic record for each year through the most recent grading/marking period.

5. **Essay OR Video.** Share your vision for a non-fiction book that has the potential to become a timeless handbook for humanity. The task involves presenting a well-thought-out explanation of why the chosen book plays this significant role. You have the flexibility to express your ideas either through a written essay, limited to a maximum of 500 words, or through a video presentation on YouTube not exceeding 2 minutes in duration. If you opt for a video presentation, please include a link to your video on YouTube with the title "Headway App Scholarship for Book Lovers [year]" (e.g., *Headway App Scholarship for Book Lovers 2026*). No additional marketing or promotional description is required in the video description.

6. **A letter of recommendation.** The letter must be from a faculty or staff member at your school or a member of the community who has worked with you in a supervisory role. The letter of recommendation should be original and should not be a duplicate of a college recommendation letter. Applicants are not permitted to include relatives as references.

All correspondence throughout the application process is sent by email. It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to monitor your email account for messages from us. Students who fail to provide a valid, active email account capable of handling bulk mail may not receive consideration.

Please note that mailed scholarship applications will not be accepted.

How recipients are selected and notified

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, a statement of goals, and an outside appraisal.

All applicants will be notified by email in October.

Correspondence throughout the application process will be by email. Students who fail to provide a valid, active email account capable of handling bulk mail may not receive consideration.

This is a competitive program. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients.

Selection of recipients is made by the Company's representatives. All applicants agree to accept the decision as final.

Award amount, payment, and tax

The Scholarship award amount is USD 1,500, paid in a single installment. Payment will be made by wire transfer to the recipient in or around November of the award year. Requests for alternate payment schedules will be considered on an individual basis and cannot be guaranteed.

The Scholarship is paid to support the recipient's education. The Scholarship may be used to pay for tuition, books, lab fees, and other related education expenses. The Company does not direct, track, or verify how the funds are spent after payment.

The Scholarship may not be fully exempt from income tax in the recipient's country of residence. Depending on local rules, the recipient may be required to include the amount of the Scholarship in their tax return. The recipient is solely responsible for determining whether the Scholarship is taxable in their jurisdiction and for reporting and paying any applicable tax. The Company does not provide tax advice and does not cover any tax-related expenses. Recipients are encouraged to consult a qualified tax advisor.

Obligations

- Recipients must complete and submit a signed Scholarship Acceptance Form before funds can be processed.

- Recipients must notify their school about the award and deliver the scholarship check to the school in a timely manner.
- Recipients are required to notify the Company of any change in address, school enrollment, or other relevant information and to send a complete transcript when requested.

No post-award content obligation. The winner is not required to produce, post, or deliver any content, including any video, social-media post, blog post, testimonial, promotional material, or other content, after receiving the award. Acceptance of the Scholarship does not create any content-creation obligation.

As the only exception to the foregoing, and as part of the Company's standard program announcement, the recipient agrees that the Company may publish on the scholarship page at <https://makeheadway.com/scholarship/>: (i) the recipient's first and last name; (ii) the year in which the Scholarship was awarded; (iii) a recent photograph of the recipient (only if the recipient voluntarily provides one); and (iv) a short personal reflection from the recipient describing what winning the Scholarship means to them, similar in format and length to the testimonials of past recipients displayed on the scholarship page.

No assignment of rights over application materials. The Company will not use the essay or video submitted as part of the application for advertising, marketing, or other commercial purposes. The applicant retains all rights in and to the content they submit.

No future employment obligation. Receipt of the Scholarship creates no obligation to work for, contract with, intern with, or otherwise provide services to the Company or any of its affiliates at any point in the future. The Scholarship is not an offer of employment and is not conditioned on any current or future commercial relationship between the recipient and the Company.

Personal data

By submitting an application, you acknowledge and agree that the Company will collect and process the personal data you provide for the purpose of administering the Scholarship program, including evaluating applications, selecting and announcing recipients, processing payment, and meeting the Company's legal obligations. Application materials will not be used for marketing or other commercial purposes. Personal data is handled in accordance with the Company's privacy policy available at <https://makeheadway.com/privacy-policy/>.

General terms

The Company may suspend, change, or terminate this program at any time without prior notice. The interpretation, application, and administration of these program provisions shall be determined by the Company at its sole discretion.

If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is held to be invalid or unenforceable under the law of a particular country, that provision shall be modified to the minimum extent necessary to

make it enforceable in that country, or, if not possible, severed, and the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

Local-law compliance. The Scholarship is offered only where permitted by applicable law. Applicants are responsible for ensuring that their participation does not contravene the laws of their country of residence.
