

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I APPLY?

SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

We receive all applications from UCAS and begin to review them.

2

INTERVIEWS

Applicants who meet the entry criteria will be invited to an interview.

OUR TIP:

Attend as many University interviews as you can to build your confidence.

POST-INTERVIEW FEEDBACK

After your interview you will receive one of three outcomes:

You receive an offer.

You're placed in the final applicant pool.

You are unsuccessful.

If you are placed in the final applicant pool, this means that we are waiting to conduct more interviews with other applicants before we make a final decision on your application.

IMPORTANT:

Being placed in the final applicant pool does not mean you have been unsuccessful.

ATTEND AN APPLICANT DAY

If you have received an offer from us, you'll then be invited to an applicant day.

Applicant days are useful to:

Gather information to inform your decision.

Find out more about your course and life at UEA.

Meet other applicants and lecturers from your course.

OUR TIP:

Be patient and wait to hear from all universities before accepting an offer.

TAKE THE TIME TO MAKE THE RIGHT DECISION FOR YOU

It's a good idea to wait until you've heard back from all your universities. That way you will have received all your offers before making your choice.

Remember, you have until the deadline in June to decide which offers to accept or decline, so wait to receive all your offers and take your time to make the right choice for you.
