



## pullout basket soft close

#### installation guide

#### Things you need to know

- · Always read the full instructions prior to installation.
- Consider possible obstructions to your parts & accessories, like hinges inside the cabinet or adjacent cabinet doors and handles, prior to installation.
- Make sure you leave plumbing and electrical work to qualified trades people. Never try this yourself.
- Make sure you always use safety gear like a mask, ear muffs and glasses when using tools.
- **Tip**: After marking out the pre-drill holes as per the instructions, take the part that is to be installed and align the appropriate holes with the markings to ensure they match up prior to pre-drilling the holes.








#### pullout basket soft close

#### pre-drilling for runners




Calculate the desired height of your basket and runners. Mark out and pre-drill two holes on each side panel of the cabinet as pictured above. Use a 2mm drill bit to pre-drill holes to a depth of roughly 2.5mm. Note: Ensure the operation of the pullout basket will not be affected by any obstructions in the cabinet like hinges prior to pre-drilling holes.

#### attaching runners




Align the runners (A) with the pre-drilled holes and using 4 x wood screws (B), fix the basket runners to the cabinet sides. Use a further 8 x 16mm wood screws to secure runners, ensuring the screws are spaced evenly on both runners and are mirrored from the left to right side.

#### securing runners

Place wire basket onto the runners, ensuring the metal supports are placed between the 2nd and 3rd wires at the front and back of the basket. Align the basket clips (C) and fix into place using the basket clip screws (D) and a hand held screw driver.



If you are installing multiple baskets in the same cabinet or pantry, repeat steps 1-3 ensuring you leave enough clearance between the baskets to accommodate the desired items. Note: If you intend to use the door mount hardware to attach a cabinet door, pot drawer or slimline door, take into consideration their size, weight and positioning as well (see steps 5-11). The maximum weight capacity for the basket includes the weight of the cabinet door or pot drawer panel if installed.



#### pre-drilling for door mount hardware




On the inside of your cabinet door, slimline door or pot drawer panel, mark out and pre-drill four holes as per the diagram above, using measurement (x) from step 5. Use a 2mm drill bit to pre-drill holes to a depth of roughly 2.5mm.

#### door mount hardware



If you intend to use the door mount hardware to attach a cabinet door, pot drawer panel or slimline door, take into consideration their size, weight and positioning as well (see steps 5-11). The maximum weight capacity for the basket includes the weight of the door or panel if installed. **Note:** Cutlery drawer panels are not suitable due to the height of the basket.



Measure from the base of the cabinet to the bottom of the basket runners (x).

#### installing door mount hardware




Disassemble the door mount hardware (E), as per the diagram above, by removing the three screws from the front piece.

Take the back piece, align with the pre-drilled holes on the door and secure into place using 2 x wood screws (B). Ensure the single screw at the top is loose for the next step.

Take the centre piece, slide the recessed section over the top front rail of the basket. Once in place, take the front piece and align with holes of the centre piece through to the back piece and screw back together, as pictured above.

## adjusting door mount hardware 8.




If required, adjust the height of door by tightening or loosening the top screw. Adjust the angle of the door by tightening or loosening the screws on the front piece. **Note:** To adjust the door panel left or right, loosen screws on the door mount hardware front piece, slide along the basket to desired position and re-tighten all screws.




# measuring for top drawer panel use 9.



When installing a second slimline door or pot drawer panel, measure from the top of the bottom door or panel to the bottom of the runner to get (x).

# pullout basket soft close pre-drilling for top drawer panel use 10.



On the inside of your slimline door or pot drawer panel, mark out and pre-drill four holes as per the diagram above, using measurement (x) from step 9. Use a 2mm drill bit to pre-drill holes to a depth of 2.5mm and fix into place using wood screws (B) provided.

Follow steps 7 and 8 to complete installation.
