



pullout baskets 2 tier soft close

installation guide

Things you need to know

- Always read the full instructions prior to installation.
- Consider possible obstructions to your part and accessories, like hinges inside the cabinet or adjacent cabinet doors and handles, prior to installation.
- Make sure you leave plumbing and electrical work to qualified trades people. Never try this yourself.
- Make sure you always use safety gear like a mask, ear muffs and glasses when using tools.
- Tip: After marking out the pre-drill holes as per the instructions, take the part that is to be installed and align the appropriate holes with the markings to ensure they match up prior to pre-drilling the holes.








pre-drilling for runners


1.



Mark out and pre-drill four holes on the cabinet base panel as pictured above. Use a 2mm drill bit to pre-drill holes to a depth of roughly 2.5mm.

pullout baskets 2 tier soft close attaching runners



Align the runners with the pre-drilled holes and using 4 x 16mm wood screws (A), fix the runners to the cabinet.

securing runners



Secure the runners to the cabinet using a further 8×16 mm wood screws, ensuring the screws are spaced evenly on both runners and are mirrored from the left to right side.

pre-drill door panel


On the inside of your cabinet door, mark out and pre-drill four holes, measuring from the bottom of the door, as pictured above. Use a 2mm drill bit to pre-drill holes to a depth of roughly 2.5mm.







attaching door panel 5.




Align the pre-drilled holes on the door with horizontal elongated holes of the door mount piece and fix into place using 4 x 16mm wood screws

Adjust the door panels across if needed, ensuring it is centred correctly before tightening the screws. Use any remaining screws for added stability, always spaced evenly and mirrored from the left to right side. **NOTE:** The maximum weight capacity for this product includes the weight of the door if installed.

Push the baskets down onto the runner base ensuring the basket clips snap onto the bottom of the basket frame. **NOTE:** Support the runner from underneath when installing baskets to prevent damage and added safety.
