ANNOUNCEMENT

20.09.2023.

The organizer **GetzenRodeo e.V.** will promote a round of the 2023 FIM Hard Enduro World Championship and FIM Hard Enduro Junior World Championship on behalf of the **DMSB**. The event will be held in accordance with the Sporting Code of the FIM together with the relevant Appendices, these Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions approved by the FIM International Jury.

Supplementary Regulations: 24MX GetzenRodeo, 2023

FIM Enduro World Championship License Holders competing for FIM Hard Enduro World Championship points in the above event shall act in accordance with:

- the FIM Hard Enduro World Championship Regulations
- the Sporting Code of the FIM (incl. all appendices).
- Supplementary Regulations as follows.
- and any instructions by the Clerk of the Course and the FIM International Jury during the event.

2) Registration

3) Administrative Control

Administrative Control for all competitors will take place on **03.11.2023** from **9:00AM - 11:00AM** at the paddock.

Competitors will have to submit:

(See: FIM HE WC Regulations 2023, 60.8.1)

- FIM Enduro World Championship License, if required.
- Starting Permission from their National Federation (FMN), if required.
- During Administrative Control, transponders and mounting instructions will be distributed.



Starting Numbers:

- Starting numbers will be handed out at the Administrative Control.
- The number will remain the same throughout the entire event.
- The numbers must go above the motorcycle headlight/number plate and on the side panels (left/right).
- If they are not well positioned, the race direction may disqualify the rider.
- If damaged, it is the rider's job to request new numbers from the organizer.

4) Technical Control

FIM HEWC competitors Technical Control will take place on **03.11.2023** from **9:00AM - 11:00AM** at the paddock.

Non FIM HEWC riders will not be subject to FIM Technical Control.

4.1) Marked Parts

All competitors must submit their motorcycle prepared according to the **FIM Technical Rules Hard Enduro 2023**.

Following parts will be marked:

- Frame (right hand steering head)
- Crankcase (right or left side)
- Silencer (on the top)

Marked parts must be used throughout the entire competition and must be in their proper place at the final examination.

4.2) Sound Control

Sound Control will be done based on the "2mMax Method".

Sound limits are:

- 114 dB/A ahead of race,
- 115 dB/A after the race.

Each rider or his mechanic can present a maximum of one (1) motorcycle and one (1) spare silencer. Should damage or deterioration occur to the original silencer it may be changed for the marked silencer without penalty.

4.3) Street Legality / Tyres

The entire **24MX GetzenRodeo** event takes place on private and public land or using only officially closed roads:

- motorcycles do not have to be street legal.
- must have a light mask mounted in the front.
- homologated Enduro and Motocross tyres are permitted, tyres shall be available to the public.
- Trial tyres are strictly forbidden.

5) Event Format 24MX GetzenRodeo - General

Location: **Paddock:** 09430 Drebach, Scharfenstein, Burgparkplatz, Germany

Duration: 2 days

Date: 03. - 04. Nov. 2023.

Format Prologue:

Qualification is based on the fastest lap time, out of 2 individual laps, set on a prologue track. Top 16 riders will race for the top positions in a head to head knockout in the evening.

Format Main Race:

2, multi-lap Hard Enduro races. All riders start in the GetzenRace (Race1), only top 20 riders of race 1 are qualified for the GetzenChamp (Race2).

For the GetzenChamp (Race2) a section will be added, which has to be passed once ,1x, by every rider, during the race.

The lap in which the rider passes through this section can be chosen by the rider.

Track marking:

- the track is clearly marked and limited by fences and track tape. Competitors have to stay in between these barriers at all time.
- in case of leaving the race track accidentally (e.g. in case of a crash), the rider has to re-enter the race track at the same point he left and as quick as possible.
- track marshals will be positioned all over the track and especially on crucial points to observe and report short cutting and other violations to the Clerk of the Course.
- all competitors have to follow the instructions from track marshals who are instructed by the Clerk of the Course.
- In case of disregard of instructions, of barriers, unsportsmanlike procuring of advantages, the organizer reserves the right to issue penalties in the form of time penalties as well as disqualification.

Refuel Area and Service Area:

The Service Area is set up close to the paddock, between race track and paddock.

Mechanics can refuel, change parts (incl. wheels) and work on their bikes only in the service area.

Any outside assistance at the track is not permitted (except supply of drinking water).

Refueling is only permitted in the Service Area using an "environmental carpet" under the bike. Bikes, riders are only allowed to enter the service area through the racetrack

Outside assistance:

- Except in the designated Service area **outside assistance is not permitted**. Neither from the public nor from team members. (e.g., spare parts, tools, fuel, food etc.) except for drinking water supply.
- Only riders can help each other
- Only track marshals are allowed to assist riders in dangerous situations or for safety reasons. The help must take place in such a way that the rider does not gain a competitive advantage (e.g., riders will be pulled aside or downwards on steep sections to re-try).
- Refueling is only permitted in Refuel Area using an "environmental mat" under the bike.



Training:

- No bikes are permitted on the track before the official race starts!
- Riding on the track before the official start may be punished with disqualification!
- Training/bike testing is permitted only in the specially marked training area and only during specified times, see **Event Schedule**.

Riders Briefing

- A mandatory riders meeting will be held ahead of each session (Prologue, Race1/2).

5.1) Prologue

Format: Qualification is based on the fastest lap time, out of 2 individual laps, set on a prologue track. Top 16 riders will race for the top 16 start positions in a head to head knockout in the evening.

If no lap is set by a rider, he will start behind the rider who set at least one lap time – starting position will be based on a drawing of the number by the organizer.

Track: will be the same as the bike setup and practice track **open from 11:00AM-01:30AM**

Timed Hard Enduro Lap - Schedule:

02:00PM – First rider to start lap 1 – starting order based on HEWC standing
20 s interval between riders

02:30PM – First rider starts lap 2– starting order based on HEWC standing
20 s interval between riders

Head to head Knockout - Evening:

Schedule

Start: 06:00 PM

Finish: 07:30 PM

Location: next to the paddock – see map

Format: Two riders start at the same time on the same track, but on different positions, see sketch below.

The first rider to finish **5 laps** is the winner of the round, and moves to the next round.

Riders knocked out in the same round will be ranked according to their qualifying time.

Round 1 Top 16 – 8 riders knocked out

Round 2 Top 8 – 4 riders knocked out

Semifinals Top 4 – 2 riders knocked out

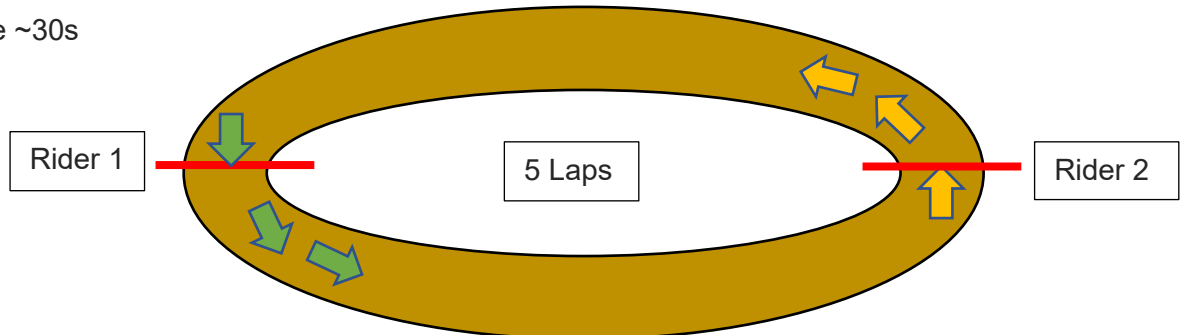
Race for P3

Track:

Lap time ~30s



Classification: Top 16 riders, according to the round they got knocked out and qualifying lap time. Rider 17 and onwards, based on the qualifying lap time.

Final ranking will be the starting order for the GetzenRace.

FIM World Championship prologue points will be awarded according to this ranking.

5.3) GetzenRace – Saturday Morning

Format: Multi-lap Hard Enduro race

Duration: 2 hours, plus one lap

Start Procedure: Mass Start, riders will be lined up in a row, Dead engine start, hands on helmet, Start will be signaled by a start light.

Restart Procedure: If due to exceptional reasons the race must be stopped, and a restart is decided by the Clerk of the Course.



Premature Stopping:

In case of a premature stop Red Flags will be waved around the track all riders have to stop immediately and return to the paddock safely.

- if more than 50% (+1h) are completed: the result will be determined by the number of laps completed in the shortest time.
- if less than 50%: the race will be restarted with a shortened duration (actual length will be determined by the Jury)

General rules:

- Riders have to cross the finish line in contact with their bikes, otherwise lap(s) don't count.
- After the checkered flag/finish, no rider is allowed to start a new lap.
- The time for finishing the last lap is 15 minutes, after the first rider reaches the finish.

Schedule:

09:40 AM Pre-Start / Positioning on starting grid

- Riders will be lined up side-by-side.

10:00 AM Start GetzenRace:

12:20 PM Finish (approx.)

Classification: In order of the number of laps completed in the shortest time.

Only the top 20 riders from the "GetzenRace", will move on to the GetzenChamp Race.

All others will be ranked according to the result of GetzenRace.

5.4) GetzenChamp – Saturday afternoon

Only the top 20 riders from the "GetzenRace" are allowed to start!

Format: Multi-lap Hard Enduro race

Track: same track as in GetzenRace , but in the **opposite direction**

Duration: 80min plus one lap

Start Procedure: Mass Start, riders will be lined up in a row, Dead engine start, hands on helmet, Start will be signaled by a start light.

Restart Procedure: If due to exceptional reasons the race must be stopped, and a restart is decided by the Clerk of the Course.

Joker Lane:

This section will be added, and has to be passed **once ,1x, by every rider**, during the Race. The lap in which the rider passes through this section can be chosen by the rider. If a rider, does not ride through the Joker Lane during the race, the penalty will be the following: **Slowest riding time of this section + 15min**



Premature Stopping:

In case of a premature stop Red Flags will be waved around the track all riders have to stop immediately and return to the paddock safely.

- if more than 50% (+40min) are completed: the result will be determined by the number of laps completed in the shortest time.
- if less than 50%: the race will be restarted with a shortened duration (actual length will be determined by the Jury).
- if less than 50% and a restarted is not possible: the result of the GetzenRace (qualifier) will become the event result and full championship points will be awarded.
- in case the GetzenChamp (main race) can't be started at all: the result of the GetzenRace (qualifier) will become the event result and full championship points will be awarded.

General rules:

- Riders have to cross the finish line in contact with their bikes, otherwise lap(s) don't count.
- After the checkered flag/finish, no rider is allowed to start a new lap.
- The time for finishing the last lap is 15 minutes, after the first rider reaches the finish.

Schedule:

01:30 PM Pre-Start / Positioning on starting grid

- Line up according to finishing position in the GetzenRace one after another (first rider, first).

02:00 PM Start GetzenChamp

- Starting order is the result from the GetzenRace (qualifier)

03:30 PM Finish (approx.)

Classification: In order of the number of laps completed in the shortest time.

03:45 PM Price Giving (approx.)

- Flower Ceremony GetzenRodeo, followed by
- FIM Hard Enduro World Championship and FIM Hard Enduro Junior World Championship ceremony directly afterwards
