

Quality and grade descriptions

General description of all grades:

- The standard grades described below only apply to Nordmann fir and Noble fir
- For other "niche" species, the applicable grade will be stated on our order confirmation for the year concerned
- Height: Measured from root collar to shoot apex

2/0 plants have:

- a well-proportioned root/shoot ratio
- a height of 10-18 cm
- a root collar diameter of at least 4 mm
- no side shoot or one single side shoot
- at least one bud in the uppermost bud whorl (incl. apical bud)
- a healthy green colour and good appearance

2/1 plants have:

- a well-proportioned root/shoot ratio
- a height of 10-20 cm (Noble fir 12-25 cm)
- a root collar diameter of at least 5 mm
- at least one side shoot
- at least 3 buds in the uppermost bud whorl (incl. apical bud)
- a healthy green colour and good appearance

3/0 plants have:

- a well-proportioned root/shoot ratio
- a height of 12-25 cm
- a root collar diameter of at least 5 mm
- at least one side shoot
- at least 3 buds in the uppermost bud whorl (incl. apical bud)
- a healthy green colour and good appearance

2/2 plants have:

- a well-proportioned root/shoot ratio
- a height of 15-35/+ cm (depending on year)
- a root collar diameter of at least 6 mm
- at least two side shoots
- at least 4 buds in the uppermost bud whorl (incl. apical bud)
- a healthy green colour and good appearance

The above-mentioned grade descriptions apply for our standard products only, i.e. if cultivation practices are altered at the request of a customer, Majland A/S standards will no longer apply. Similarly, Majland A/S standard grades only apply to plants propagated from seed batches received from our own seed suppliers. Majland A/S standard grades shall therefore not be applicable in cultivation agreements involving seed delivered to Majland A/S by the customer. In such cases, applicable grades will be described in the cultivation agreement.
