FINDING YOUR WAY AROUND

Our Blenheim Walk building can be a little confusing to navigate at first, so here are some tips to help. From the main entrance and reception area, rooms to the right have codes beginning with B1 (building area 1) and rooms to the left have codes beginning with B2 (building area 2).

- **The Auditorium is in building area 1** - turn right from reception, up the steps and it's directly in front of you.
- **The Library is in building area 1** - turn right from reception, take the lift up to the 3rd floor
- **The Café is in building area 2** - turn left from reception, go through the turnstiles, up the steps, turn left and follow the corridor straight into the Café
- **Student Administration and Student Advice & Wellbeing are in building area 2** - go past the Café and you will find their offices on the right-hand side of the corridor
- **The Student Union is in building area 2** - you can find them at the back of the Café

Your course is based in building area 2, on the first floor.
