- Learn hygiene, food hazards, how to prevent cross contamination, and more
- Learn codes and regulations

3 . Responsible Service of Alcohol - RSA (optional)

- "RSA" Responsible Serving Alcohol
- On completion of the training, sisters are awarded a nationally recognised training certificate, SITHFAB002
- Understand the laws and regulations
- Learn customer service skills
