

Polished

The shiniest and smoothest finish by far, bringing out the best in the colours, veins and minerals.



Honed

A warm, matt shine created with a scoured surface. The grain used for scouring determines the final result.

Brosso Vecchio

This unusual matt finish has been developed especially for marble. The surface is gently brushed to give it a 'leather touch' and accentuate its natural colour.



Sensato

This mechanical treatment gives the dolomite marble a somewhat rough, matt look that is pleasant to the touch.
