TruStone Initiative

TruStone is a joint initiative in which the Flemish and Dutch natural stone industry, Flemish and Dutch governments, NGOs and trade unions work together towards the responsible production and purchase of natural stone.

Within the initiative, we work together to meet all the main international standards for responsible procurement. The OECD Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises serve as the starting point for the TruStone Initiative. The guidelines are aligned with the United Nations Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights and incorporate relevant elements of the ILO Core Labour Standards. These standards include both social and environmental guidelines.

Brachot participated in the start-up of this initiative. Together with the Brachot Family Members, we aim for fair and sustainable extraction and production of natural stone worldwide, while respecting labour conditions, environment, safety, and human rights. Each Family Member commits to mapping the entire chain, from extraction to distribution, so that issues can be clearly identified and addressed.

No Child Left Behind

Through the No Child Left Behind project, Brachot initiated a collaboration with foreign partners and international and local NGOs in India. No Child Left Behind is a project founded on the vision that every child has the right to a childhood and quality education. By providing long-term support to the NGO Manjari, we are improving the lives of local families. Active efforts are made to keep children in Rajasthan, India, away from natural stone production and grant them access to high-quality education. These endeavours involve age verification, an increased number of teachers in schools, and the establishment of eight awareness centres for parents and children, even before they begin schooling. The outcome is remarkable: a significant reduction in child labour in the region and a considerable increase in the number of children returning to school.

Our Contribution in the Chain


We actively participate in risk assessments and stakeholder dialogues conducted by TruStone and the No Child Left Behind project. The priorities set within these projects are implemented at the regional level by local organizations. Progress is reported on the TruStone website. Furthermore, we engage in direct conversations with our suppliers about these significant goals, and where necessary, we provide support in implementation. In the past year, we introduced the E-shram card at various suppliers in Rajasthan, contributing to transparency in labour relations and payroll administration. Additionally, we have established drinking water points and created shaded areas.

Robust character

Tarn is a durable, extremely strong natural stone with an abrasion resistance of more than 100 MPa, low porosity of less than 0.5% and high frost resistance (> 168 cycles). It is therefore particularly suitable for paving projects and locations with heavy usage and foot traffic, such as public spaces.

This French Tarn is composed of alkaline and plagioclase feldspars, grey quartz and black biotite. That gives this natural stone its unique variations in granularity and colour.








Abrasion-resistant finishes

Standard surface finishes such as flaming or shot blasting yield an anti-slip stone with a rough look and a robust feel. If you prefer the purity of a stone hewn directly from a block, the cut finish is the perfect choice. Bespoke in-house developed finishes are also available for any project.

Aesthetic value

At Brachot, we not only use Tarn, sourced from our own quarries near the Granitarn production site in Burlats, but we also process blocks of Rose de la Clarté. The coarse-grained, pink-red granite variety is extracted from our own quarries in Brittany (Perros-Guirec). This beautiful stone is processed into tiles, kerbstones, and other products. This unique and distinctive French natural stone lends public paving projects a unique look and feel.





Raw materials

Larvik Granite extracts raw blocks of the world-famous Larvikite in various colours directly from its own quarries: Blue Pearl #1 LG, Blue Pearl #9, Blue Pearl #8, Silver Pearl #5, Emerald Pearl #6, Blue Antique #7, and Nordlys. This magnificent stone originated from volcanic activity that occurred around 300 million years ago and is characterized by large, sparkling feldspar crystals. Unique blue crystals are embedded in the lush dark blue stone of our Blue Pearl, while Silver Pearl boasts radiant silver edges. Emerald Pearl offers an elegant dark green background, and Blue Antique is characterized by a warm brown backdrop.

These blocks can then be cut by other Brachot Family Members into paving products.
