



SPARKLERS

The use of handheld sparklers within the grounds of Ashridge House is permitted however the following guidance should be followed when they are used.

Sparklers are often seen as harmless however they burn at fierce temperatures equivalent to a welding torch and can cause burns if not used responsibly.

The use of sparklers on the site is entirely at your own risk, this information sheet has been put in place for the benefit and safety of our other guests and the protection of the house and gardens.

- You must be over 6 meters away from any building before lighting a sparkler
- Sparklers should not be given to children under 5 years of age
- Make sure everyone handling sparklers wears gloves
- Hold sparklers at arm's length while being lit and light them one at a time
- Don't wave sparklers about close to other people
- When the sparklers have finished place them in the bucket of sand provided.

During periods of dry weather, permission to use sparklers may be withdrawn to maintain the safety of Ashridge House and gardens.
