Dachstein Krippenstein in the Upper Austrian Salzkammergut offers an exciting outdoor programme – far away from the mainstream. On the pistes, Dachstein Krippenstein impresses with exceptional skiing opportunities – gentle slopes for warming up and learning to ski both on the mountain and in the valley, as well as Upper Austria's longest ski run, stretching nine kilometres with an altitude difference of 1,500 metres.

The Dachstein Plateau is also a true paradise for ski-tourers. From relaxed half-day tours to multi-day ski tours, there is something for everyone. Those who prefer a more leisurely pace can explore Dachstein Krippenstein on snowshoes. Three signposted snowshoe trails and winter hiking trails lead to the 5fingers, the World Heritage Spiral and the Dachstein Shark.

Dachstein Krippenstein is a hotspot for the freeride scene. Rugged rocky ridges, varied slopes and technical forest sections demand stamina and concentration. More than 30 kilometres of freeride routes and powder runs await.

We're also committed to sustainability, helping to ensure a truly memorable experience. In addition to e-charging stations, all lifts are supplied with electricity from renewable energy sources! Sustainable, naturally!

Tip: The seminar and event room at an altitude of 2,100 metres with views of the Dachstein is a unique venue and ideal for events, seminars, workshops and meetings.

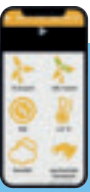

Family bonus: Children born in 2021 or later receive a free pass when accompanied by a parent (Family ID required). Age must be verified with an official photo ID. Free travel from the third child onwards – every additional child receives a free pass.

All ski tickets are issued on KeyCards. Deposit: € 2.00. Other data carriers are not accepted. All prices are in euros and include 10% VAT. Any misuse of ski tickets will result in the withdrawal of the ski ticket and exclusion from transportation.

Important information

Ski ticket refunds in the event of a skiing accident: Refunds are only granted if the ski ticket has been handed in at one of our cash desks. The period of use is calculated from the date of issue until the ticket is handed in. A medical certificate must be presented when claiming a cash refund. Refunds are only available for ski tickets valid for three days or more. No cash refund can be granted to family members who end their holiday early due to the injured person's departure.

Piste accidents: A rescue fee is payable for rescue operations following accidents on the pistes.

Ski tickets are non-transferable. Lost or forgotten ski tickets cannot be replaced. Bad weather, unforeseen early departure, interruptions to operations or the closure of ski runs do not entitle the holder to a refund or extension. Ski tickets cannot subsequently be exchanged for another ticket, transferred to another person, extended or postponed.

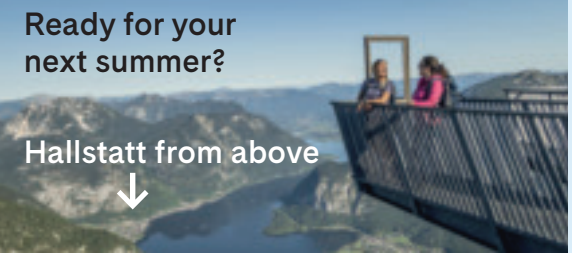

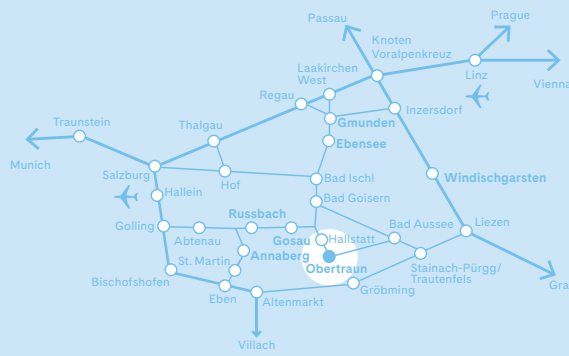

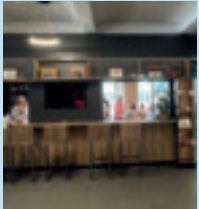

→ Skitour Heilbronner Trail

The Heilbronner Trail, which leads through the high-alpine winter landscape of the Dachstein Plateau, is fully marked with poles. In addition to impressive views of the Dachstein Glacier, the route leads from the mountain station past the Dachstein Shark and the Heilbronner Cross to Gjaid Station.

The Skitour Heilbronner Trail can also be completed on snowshoes.

Please note: The Skitour Heilbronner Trail is not protected against alpine hazards, is not groomed and not track-set. Proceed at your own risk!

→ Early Bird Ski Touring

From 14 February 2027, the first cable car departs at 7:30 am every Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

→ Natural Wonder – Fascination Dachstein

Snowshoe Trails



Discover the breathtaking winter landscape of Dachstein Krippenstein on the three signposted snowshoe trails, with fantastic views of the Dachstein Glacier.

Please note: You are in high-alpine terrain. Ensure you have suitable equipment and take the necessary emergency precautions.

Yeti Snowshoe Ticket

For winter hikers wishing to explore Dachstein Krippenstein on snowshoes, our popular Yeti Snowshoe Ticket (combined ticket) is the perfect choice.

The Yeti Snowshoe Ticket includes Ascent & Descent with the Dachstein Krippenstein cable cars (all three sections), plus snowshoe rental from Sport Jirka at the valley station.

→ Winter Hike No. 1: World Heritage Spiral

Difficulty: Easy
Duration: 45 min. (round trip)
Distance: 0.5 km → approx. 32 metres of elevation gain

From the Dachstein Krippenstein Mountain Station, the trail passes directly beneath the third section of the cable car and continues southwest. After approximately 50 metres, you will reach several small huts. Beyond the huts, a short but slightly steeper ascent follows. Continue for around 150 metres to the east and you will arrive at your destination. The World Heritage Spiral offers spectacular 360-degree panoramic views of the surrounding mountains. Return to the Dachstein Krippenstein Mountain Station via the same route.

→ Snowshoe Trail No. 2: 5fingers

Difficulty: Easy
Duration: 1 hour (round trip)
Distance: 1 km → approx. 120 metres of elevation gain

From the Dachstein Krippenstein Mountain Station, the trail passes directly beneath the third section of the cable car and continues southwest. After approximately 50 metres, you will reach several small huts. Beyond the huts, a short but slightly steeper ascent follows. Continue for around 100 metres to the east until you reach the Heilbronner Chapel. From there, the trail descends to the left before turning right and continuing gently downhill for approximately 200 metres into a small hollow. It then climbs gently again to a small ridge. Once at the top, the trail bears slightly left and descends over a small snow cornice. After a further 50 metres, keeping slightly to the right, you will reach your destination. Return via the same route.

Important: Depending on the snow conditions, the route may vary.

→ Snowshoe Trail No. 3: Dachstein Shark

Difficulty: Easy to moderate
Duration: 1.5 hours (round trip)
Distance: 3.4 km → approx. 220 metres of elevation gain

The trail starts at the Dachstein Krippenstein Mountain Station, where the route is clearly signposted. It first follows the ski piste towards the base station of the chairlift, reaching a platter lift in the hollow after approximately 15 minutes. After crossing the lift track at the upper end, you leave the controlled ski area. The route then continues through open alpine terrain, descending gently before climbing again for approximately 15 metres of elevation gain. At this point, you will also find the small Krippenstein Ice Cave, which can be explored independently when snow conditions permit. About 50 metres beyond the ice cave, the trail branches off half-left and follows a gently sloping hillside in a north-easterly direction for approximately 20 minutes until you reach the Dachstein Shark. Return via the same route.

Tip: Enjoy a stop at the mountain restaurant with its spectacular views.
