



Admission Requirements

EF admission requirements vary by program, but generally include completing an enrollment form, paying a non-refundable fee, and providing a passport and other documents like transcripts and personal statements for academic programs. There are no specific academic prerequisites for EF's language learning programs, but programs like the University Foundation require a certain level of English proficiency, often demonstrated by tests like TOEFL or IELTS or by taking EF's free placement test.

General and Intensive Language Courses

Anyone who wants to learn English is welcome to join, with no specific prerequisites other than age. The minimum age to attend classes at EF Vancouver is 16.

TOEFL/Exams Preparation

Proof of language level/testing requirements - EFSET (50-minute), UPiBT, TOEFL, or IELTS:

- EF SET – 51
- EF Level – B2.1
- TOEFL – 72

University Pathways

In order to confirm the course and send the **Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL)**, we will need you to work with your Sales Office to provide the following:

1. Proof of language level/testing requirements - EFSET (50-minute), UPiBT, TOEFL, or IELTS
2. UP Statement of Purpose & signed disclaimer (available through the Sales Office)
3. Academic documents and English translations:
 - a. High school transcripts and diploma with English translations
 - b. Proof of completion of High School

Language Level/Testing Requirements:

- EF SET – 54
- UPiBT – 50
- EF Level – B2.2 (if transferring from another EF course)
- TOEFL – 75
