
Compliance with Restrictions on PFAS Presence in Products

Dear Sir/Madam

The products we market comply with the currently applicable restrictions and information requirements concerning the presence of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) within the EU.

We are well-aware of the proposed universal PFAS restriction covering over 10 000 substances, submitted in February 2023 to the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) by Germany, the Netherlands, Norway, Sweden, and Denmark.

However, as of now, only a limited number of PFAS is classified as hazardous according to the CLP Regulation and none of our products contains these already-regulated PFAS.

To prepare for the upcoming universal restriction, we are in contact with our suppliers to get additional information. Please rest assured that we are making every effort to comply with the restriction once definitively adopted which should not come into effect until at least 2027.
