



PPWR Compliance Statement of Tyrolit AG

(Regulation (EU) 2025/40 – Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation, "PPWR")

Tyrolit AG hereby confirms that the packaging used for its products and placed on the market by it fulfils the requirements of Article 5 PPWR applicable as of 12 August 2026. This comprises the minimisation of substances of concern pursuant to Article 5(1) PPWR, compliance with the sum concentration limit of 100 mg/kg for lead, cadmium, mercury and hexavalent chromium pursuant to Article 5(4) PPWR, and – insofar as food-contact packaging is concerned – compliance with the PFAS limit values pursuant to Article 5(5) PPWR.

This statement is based on the technical documentation, declarations of conformity and supporting evidence provided by our packaging suppliers, as well as on our own assessment and release processes. Should Tyrolit AG become aware that packaging supplied to customers does not comply with the aforementioned requirements, it will inform the affected customers without undue delay.

For packaging for which Tyrolit AG qualifies as the manufacturer within the meaning of Article 3 PPWR, Tyrolit AG draws up the technical documentation and the EU declaration of conformity in accordance with the requirements of the PPWR and retains such documents for the statutory retention periods. The applicable requirements concerning identification, labelling and traceability, including the particulars of the responsible economic operator, are fulfilled. Conformity information and – where required by law – the EU declaration of conformity will be made available to customers upon request.

To ensure consistent and efficient communication, Tyrolit AG issues this standardised statement. As a general rule, Tyrolit AG does not sign customer-specific PPWR declarations or forms; the substantive requirements of such documents are covered by this statement.

This statement refers to the requirements of the PPWR applicable as of its date of issue. Requirements with a later date of application (in particular concerning recyclability, recycled content and harmonised labelling) will be implemented within the applicable statutory deadlines. Tyrolit AG continuously monitors regulatory developments under the PPWR and will update this statement as necessary. This statement is provided for information purposes within the supply chain and does not constitute an EU declaration of conformity within the meaning of Article 39 PPWR.
