Jafurah Project piping module loadout - KSA





DUMAT AL JANDAL

Project Overview

Dumat Al-Jandal (DAJ) is a 400MW onshore wind farm project that will be Saudi Arabia's first utility scale wind power source. DAJ, located in the Al Jouf region of north-west Saudi Arabia, is 1,200km from the industrial city of Jubail. The wind farm comprises 99 Vestas V150 HH124m (+6m) 4.2MW wind turbines shipped through Duba Port, located in the Red Sea area.

SNME Scope

- **Cargo Handling & Transportation | Contractor – Al Majdouie**
 - SNME supplied five mobile crane (250t – 50t) and safely lifted 1,000+ WTG components onto specialized trailers for transport the location some 700km away.
- **Onsite Installation | Contractor – Anipsotiki**
 - SNME supplied cranes, equipment and manpower to assist the erection and installation of the wind turbines. Two main cranes(CC3800-1 & CC2800-1) are used for the erection, with the CC2400-1 being used for the preinstallation works. Tailing cranes (AC130-5) are supporting the main cranes. Additional mobile cranes (100t – 220t) are used for placing WTG components on the pads.






