NOTICE OF HEARING

A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee") regarding the Application of Wild Stallion Energy Storage LLC ("Applicant") for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility ("CEC") authorizing construction of the Wild Stallion Energy Storage System Gen-Tie Project ("Project").

The Project includes an approximately 2-mile, 230 kilovolt ("kV") transmission line from the Wild Stallion battery energy storage system to Arizona Public Service Company's Trilby Wash 230-kV substation. All Project components are located in Maricopa County, Arizona. A map of the Project is attached as **Exhibit A**.

The hearing will be held at the Windmill Suites, 12545 W. Bell Rd., Surprise, AZ 85378. **The hearing will begin on Monday, August 10, 2026 at 1:00 p.m. and will continue as necessary through Friday, August 14, 2026, beginning at 9:00 a.m. each day at the same location until completion of the hearing.** If any revisions to the hearing schedule are required, they will be noticed on the Project website at <https://us.baywa->

9 **CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE.**

10 **THE PUBLIC HAS THE OPTION TO WATCH THE HEARING ONLINE**
11 **OR LISTEN TO THE HEARING VIA TELEPHONE.** At least 24 hours in advance of
12 the hearing, information regarding online and telephone hearing access, as well as any,
13 additional details regarding safety protocols or other revisions to the hearing schedule will
14 be noticed on the Project website at [https://us.baywa-re.com/en/projects/local-](https://us.baywa-re.com/en/projects/local-projects/wild-stallion-energy-storage)

16 The Chairman may, at his discretion, recess the hearing to a time and place to be
17 announced during the hearing, or to be determined after recess. The date, time, and place
18 at which the hearing will be resumed will be posted on the above-noted Project and ACC
19 websites. **NOTE: NOTICE OF ANY SUCH RESUMED HEARING WILL BE**
20 **GIVEN; HOWEVER, PUBLISHED NOTICE OF SUCH A RESUMED HEARING**
21 **IS NOT REQUIRED.**

22 If the Committee decides to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and itinerary
23 of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project and ACC
24 websites. Members of the public may follow the Committee on the tour. During the tour,
25 the Committee may hear testimony at stops concerning elements of the Project. No other
26 discussion or deliberation concerning the Application will occur during the tour. A court
27 reporter or recording device will record any testimony taken on the tour for transcription.

1 Public health and safety protocols specific for the tour will be included on the itinerary. If
2 the Committee decides not to take a tour, the hearing will continue as scheduled.

10 The Applicant will make available final copies of the pre-filing conference, pre-
11 hearing conference, and hearing transcripts at each of the above locations and website.

12 Each county, municipal government, and state agency interested in the Project that
13 desires to be a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date set
14 for the hearing, file a Notice of Intent to Become a Party with the Director of Utilities,
15 ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007.

16 Any domestic non-profit corporation or association formed in whole or in part to
17 promote conservation or natural beauty; to protect the environment, personal health, or
18 other biological values; to preserve historical sites; to promote consumer interests; to
19 represent commercial and industrial groups; or to promote the orderly development of the
20 area in which the Project is located desiring to become a party to the proceedings shall, not
21 less than ten (10) days before the date set for the hearing, file Notice of Intent to Become
22 a Party with the Director of Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ
23 85007.

24 The Committee may make other persons parties to the proceedings at any time. Any
25 person may make a limited appearance at the hearing by filing a statement in writing with
26 the Director of Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007, and the
27 Chairman of the Committee at 2005 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85004, not less

1 than five (5) days before the date set for the hearing. A person making a limited appearance
2 will not be a party or have the right to present testimony or cross-examine witnesses.

3 This proceeding governed by Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") §§ 40-360 to 40-
4 360.13 and A.A.C. R14-7-101 to R14-7-120. No substantive communication, not in the
5 public record, may be made to any member of the Committee. The written decision of the
6 Committee will be submitted to the ACC pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-360.07. Any person
7 intending to be a party to the proceedings on the matter before the ACC must be a party to
8 the proceedings before the Committee.

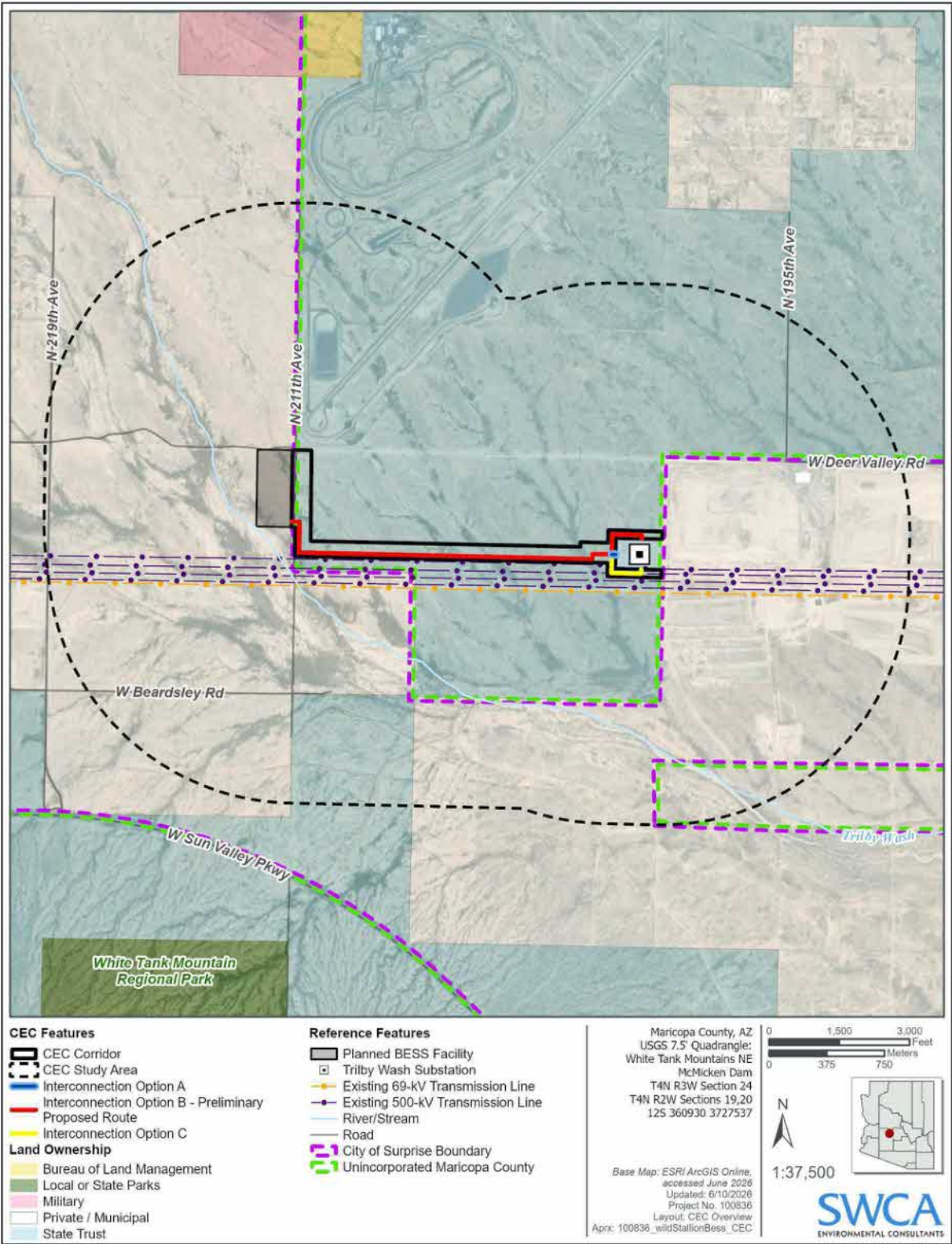
