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Royal Navy officer honoured by The Queen for role in Digitising Human Resources within the Royal Navy.

A Royal Navy officer from Sanquhar has been instrumental in empowering sailors and marines with the development of a series of applications to allow users to access their information via a mobile device and is being honoured by The Queen for his efforts.

Lieutenant Commander Richard Burns headed a team to digitally transform the way the Royal Navy managed its people, replacing legacy systems and processes with new ways of working, through automation, innovative technology, and mobile applications which cumulated with the rollout of MyNavy and later MyRAF. Throughout the COVID-19 Pandemic he directly contributed to maintaining the Royal Navy's operational capability by developing at speed a 'COVID reporting tool' to allow all users the ability to report their status to Command, achieving 95+% accuracy it was described as 'best in class' by industry. Lieutenant Commander Richard Burns earns an MBE – the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire – in the Queen's Birthday Honours list for his efforts.

He will be presented with his award at an investiture in the coming months.
