

## The Site

Cloud Hill is next to the existing Whiteside Hill Wind Farm. BayWa r.e. acquired the site in 2021, and has been working with Blue Energy to progress the project.

The wind farm will be accessed via a new site entrance between Blackaddie Road and Eliock Bridge. The land is currently open moor and grazing land. Existing tracks on site will be used to minimise the amount of new track needed.
