Host parents who serve as firefighters, law enforcement, Emergency Medical Services as well as active or veteran military members, can save \$1,000 off their program fee when they welcome their first au pair. To be eligible, families must provide proof of service or employment, be new to Cultural Care, and must host for a term of at least 26 weeks. Discount cannot be combined with other offers.
