

Tradition, forged in steel.

In 1895, Grythyttan's founder, Karl Lindqvist, and his friend, the blacksmith and mechanic Theodor Berg, stepped off the train in the small village of Grythytted. They carried few possessions, besides a powerful vision to start their own forge, offering first-class craftsmanship and fine steel products. Both were already skilled blacksmiths, and they soon became well-known for their excellent horseshoes and axes, which were described as 'unsurpassed in strength and sharpness.'

Grythyttan's very first chair was, in fact, forged from horseshoe steel. In 1930, Karl's son, Artur, spotted an advert for the Stockholm Exhibition in the newspaper. It included a picture of a German chair made from steel tubing, with just two legs rather than the usual four. Artur, who had already encountered modernism and the Bauhaus movement during a youth exchange programme in Germany for young entrepreneurs was inspired to start sketching his own model.

In order to make his chair as comfortable and relaxing as possible, Artur used spring steel for the frame. And he shaped the backrest and seat into a continuous line that followed the form of the chair's body. The construction was innovative, with clean lines and a distinctive rocking sensation. Everyone who tried the chair claimed it was more comfortable than any garden chair they had ever sat on before. It was not only unique, but also stable and elegant.

When Artur was satisfied with his prototype, he commissioned the nearby Hellefors factory to produce a few hundred kilos of spring steel in the correct dimensions. The chair attracted great attention in the famous department store Nordiska Kompaniet's booth at the Stockholm Exhibition.

Plenty of water has flowed under the bridge at Grythytted since Artur's first garden chair was conceived. Multiple chairs, tables, stools, benches, and garden sofas have been added to the family. What they all have in common is their timeless design, exceptional durability and welcoming character. To this day, all Grythyttan Stålmöbler's furniture is crafted by hand in our own factory in Bergslagen. A team of blacksmiths, machine operators, and other craftspeople ensure that every piece is finished to perfection. The steel is bent, screws are tightened by experienced hands, and every piece of wood is carefully selected. Only if the colour, quality and grain of the wood are all perfect can a plank be used in one of our chairs. This ensures a robust product that will last for generations.

Lots of children have already inherited their parents' Grythyttan furniture, steeped in memories. Still used and loved, this furniture can be passed down to the next generation, and the next.

And every piece is a testament to the wonder of nature – a reminder of the pine-covered coastline, the ore-rich mountains and the forests which stretch all the way to the horizon.

Through our craftsmanship, we carry the torch of history into the future. Over the last 130 years we've refined, improved, and further developed the strength, stability and beauty of the Grythyttan Stålmöbler furniture.

The original chair has been slightly updated and is now available in several new versions. Look for Armchair A2 in the Classic series.

The Classic series.

The iconic Classic series was first launched at the 1930 Stockholm Exhibition and is characterised by its functional design and signature rocking sensation. With furniture from the Classic Series, the result will always be stylish. Choose between three wood species: teak, South American oak, or Swedish pine. For maximum durability, all the chairs and sofas are made with solid steel frames. The teak and South American oak furniture in this series is available with both hot galvanized and powder-coated frames. The pine furniture is available with green powder-coated frames. All the wood comes from sustainably managed forests and is environmentally certified according to FSC® or the Swedish PEFC forest standard.®








NEW. The Classic series sofa 3 in teak with black base. Chair 1 in pine with black base.






Bovik.


Bovik is a small village by Lake Torrvärpen, just across from Grythyttan. The landscape here is shaped by silence and the steady rhythm of nature. That quiet, natural elegance has inspired a new product series – a sibling to Grythyttan Stålmöbler's Classic series, with a character of its own.

The foundation is the same timeless craftsmanship: forged spring steel with its distinctive flexibility, offering both comfort and stability. The materials, the forge, and the workmanship all come from the same tradition. But in the Bovik series, the expression moves in a new direction. The teak slats are more numerous, slimmer, and lighter, giving the furniture a more slender silhouette. The result is a collection that carries the same heritage as the classics, but with the unmistakable feel of Bovik.

High Tech.


Stylish and understated, the High Tech gives you spring steel comfort in either hot galvanised or powder-coated steel. Designed by Swedish architect and furniture designer Nisse Strinning, the chair is both stable and stackable. The table tops in water-repellent compact laminate are highly weather-resistant. The table bases can be removed for easy storage.

Nisse Strinning is considered one of the great Scandinavian architects and furniture designers. In 1949, together with his wife, Kajsa Strinning, he designed the iconic String System. In 1984, he designed the High Tech chair for Grythyttan Stålmöbler, which is now considered a style-defining design classic.





The Brewery series.



Regardless which wood species you choose, rest assured that all our wood comes from sustainable forestry and is environmentally certified according to the FSC forest standard.


The Libelle chair was designed by the renowned Norwegian designer, Andreas Engesvik. It is fully welded for extra strength and flexibility, but nonetheless retains a light, elegant appearance. Stackable and compact, the Libelle chair is especially suitable for smaller spaces.

Andreas Engesvik is one of the foremost contemporary designers in Norway. Within the world of design, he has made a name for himself in everything from furniture and tableware to industrial design, with commissions for international clients such as Iittala, Muuto, Ligne Roset and Fogia. Over the years, Andreas has won numerous awards, including the Red Dot Award, the Wallpaper Design Award and the Bruno Mathsson Award.





Craftsmanship and types of wood.



All production is still carried out by hand in the factory in Grythyttan. The steel is bent and shaped using spirit levels, trained eyes, and years of expertise.

We use only South American oak, teak, and Swedish pine with the highest environmental certifications. Each plank is carefully selected by our craftsmen. They study the colour, grain, density and appearance of the wood. No knots or cracks are allowed.

South American oak is a very stable type of wood, that's highly suitable for outdoor environments. It's also excellent for painting, giving you an exceptionally durable and hardwearing surface. When oiled, the wood is even more beautiful, ranging in colour from light amber to a darker olive shade. Teak is regarded as a valuable, high-quality wood species due to its durability, soft aroma, golden colour and durability.

All our teak comes from certified plantations in South America. As for our Swedish pine furniture, we only use planks with vertical annual rings. When the rings follow the same direction as the short side of the furniture, there is no risk of warping. The surface also becomes harder, which in turn makes the wooden parts more stable, durable.

Thanks to this rigorous approach to quality, our furniture ages very well. Like all living materials, the wood is affected by the sun, wind, rain and moisture, and become even more beautiful over time. Look after your Grythyttan furniture and you'll certainly be able to enjoy it for many years to come, even if you leave it outside. The steel surfaces are galvanized or lacquered, before the wooden parts are assembled and the quality stamp is screwed on. No two pieces of furniture from the Grythyttan factory are identical – and that's something we're proud of!

Certification for sustainable forestry.

When you purchase one of our products, we believe you have the right to know where the material comes from and how it has been produced. To this end, we work with certification organisations and environmental labeling, so you can trace our materials throughout the value chain, all the way from the raw material to the finished product. The wooden components in our furniture all carry environmental certifications from one of two leading organisations, both of which share our vision for responsible forestry. This guarantees that the materials used in any products you buy from us always meet the relevant social and environmental standards.

Firstly, the teak and South American oak we use are certified by FSC®, the *Forest Stewardship Council*®. FSC is an international organisation with members from various environmental and social organisations, and economic stakeholders. Together, they strive towards making the world's forests environmentally sustainable, socially responsible, and economically viable. FSC® is the only wood product certification supported by WWF, the World Wildlife Fund. Grythyttan's licence number is FSC® C153972.

Secondly, the pine we use is certified by the *Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification* (PEFC). This is an international organisation of forestry companies whose members work together to promote sustainable forestry, focusing on environmental, economic and social sustainability.
