Women's Cyber Leadership Program

The Women in Cyber Leadership Program is a high-impact leadership program designed to advance the careers of women in cybersecurity and digital risk across Malaysia and the Indo-Pacific.

This five-day, in-person program builds essential leadership capabilities, focusing on cybersecurity strategy, digital risk, and executive communications. Learners will participate in lectures, panels, and interactive exercises led by global experts and regional leaders.

By fostering skills, confidence, and networks, the program will help empower a new generation of women leaders to take an active role in securing a resilient digital landscape throughout the Indo-Pacific.

This program is delivered through the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission and BlackBerry's Cybersecurity Center of Excellence (CCoE) in Cyberjaya and Rogers Cybersecure Catalyst at Toronto Metropolitan University, in partnership with the Government of Canada.

This program is designed for women professionals in mid-level management roles within cybersecurity and related fields. We welcome participants from across Malaysia and the broader Indo-Pacific region who are committed to personal and professional growth and are ready to take the next step in their careers. Candidates are typically responsible for leading teams, managing cyber risks, and shaping their organization's security strategy.

Applicants will need to submit:

2. Written responses to the following questions:
 - o Why are you interested in this program?
 - o What makes you passionate about cybersecurity and leadership in this field?
 - o What are your career goals and how will this program help?

Successful applicants will be notified of their decisions in December 2025.

Eligibility

Women citizens or permanent residents of ASEAN member state, subject to review under applicable laws and sanctions.

Travel Bursaries for Regional Participants

The Women in Cyber Leadership Program is free of charge thanks to the generous support of our partners.

Travel bursaries are available for ASEAN nominees selected for the program who live outside of Malaysia. ASEAN nominees will receive funding for transportation, accommodation, and daily meal allowances. We will work directly with accepted applicants to coordinate these details.

Malaysian participants will be responsible for arranging their own travel and accommodation.
