



What does the insurance cover?

The insurance covers material damage or loss to insured property stored in a unit rented from Cityvarasto, resulting from the following events:

1. Moths, insects or pests from an external source
2. Theft related to a break-in
3. Vandalism
4. Water or other liquid damage
5. Pipe burst and/or leak
6. Storm, flood, wind
7. Fire
8. Lightning strike
9. Explosion
10. Earthquake
11. Aircraft or objects falling from aircraft
12. Riot, strike, civil unrest
13. Collision with a vehicle, train or railway carriage

Property refers to goods and other items placed in storage.

What does the insurance not cover?

1. Cash
2. Securities
3. Precious metals
4. Moths, insects and pests from an external source (compensation limit up to €4,000)
5. Jewellery with a combined value exceeding €1,000
6. Works of art
7. Items with significant sentimental value
8. Anything Cityvarasto has prohibited from being stored

- 9. More than three sets of tyres
- 10. Batteries
- 11. Foodstuffs and perishable goods
- 12. Fireworks, explosives, weapons and ammunition
- 13. Drugs, toxic and radioactive substances
- 14. Illegal property
- 15. Damage caused by Cityvarasto's negligence

The insurance also does not cover damage resulting from:

- 1. Unexplained disappearance or a defective storage unit
- 2. War, invasion, rebellion or revolution
- 3. Pressure waves caused by supersonic aircraft
- 4. Terrorism
- 5. Confiscation, nationalisation, expropriation or an order by an authority
