

## DEAUVILLE BIKE ITINERARY

**MAIRIE DE SAINT-ARNOULT** 

Saint-Arnoult's town hall is the starting point for an enchanting cycle path that snakes along the tranquil, silvery River Morte. This bucolic itinerary offers up welcome shady stretches, and is a chance to fully unwind and engage with the local countryside. The perfect choice for getting out and about in the great outdoors, mere minutes away from the town center.

2 LEISURE PARK

This luscious, green 11-hectare park is a stone's throw from the Deauville-La Touques racecourse and makes the perfect setting for kicking back or getting moving thanks to its playgrounds, sports pitches, fitness trails and shaded paths. Great for families and fitness enthusiasts alike.

BOULEVARD MAUGER CYCLE ROUTE

Head to Boulevard Mauger in Deauville and segue onto a gorgeous 3-kilometer greenway that hugs the Touques racecourse and runs all the way to Saint-Arnoult. This leg of the 'Vélomaritime' trail continues along quiet country roads, where half-timbered houses, 'bocage' hedgerows and marshes await: the perfect route for glimpses of local life and country living in the heart of Normandy's countryside.

VILLA STRASSBURGER

Don't leave without a trip to the majestic Villa Strassburger. This sumptuous residence is a testimony to Deauville's neo-Norman style and was originally built for Baron Henri de Rothschild. Today, it is a listed historic monument nestled in beautifully landscaped grounds, and offers a journey back through the mists of time thanks to the historical, architectural and cultural events it hosts throughout the year.

**5** RUE BOVARY

Deauville's charming, understated Rue Bovary is the epitome of the town's quiet elegance: the street's authentic villas and pristine gardens are a chance to get away from the buzz of the waterfront for a fresh take on this iconic seaside resort.
