FROM GENERATION TO GENERATION KNOWLEDGE, TRANSMISSION AND INNOVATION

Barrière is above all a family business, passed down from generation to generation. It is a Group that has never stopped developing in France and abroad and diversifying around its core business: hospitality and related leisure activities.

1912–1962 FRANÇOIS ANDRÉ

François André created modern tourism in Deauville, then in La Baule in 1926. An entrepreneur at heart, he invented the concept of the “Frenchstyle resort”, bringing together a casino, hotels and sports facilities in the same place.

1962–1990 LUCIEN BARRIÈRE

In 1962, Lucien Barrière, François André’s nephew, took over the Group he had joined ten years earlier. He modernized it with a view to maintaining tradition and preserving the prestigious resorts bequeathed by his uncle. In 1980, in order to unite all the establishments he owned, he created the Société Hôtelière de la Chaîne Lucien Barrière (SHCLB) and brought together the hotels and the casino of La Baule under its umbrella.

From 1990 DIANE BARRIÈRE

In the early 1990s, Diane Barrière succeeded her adoptive father Lucien Barrière. She initiated major renovation projects and, in particular, created the inimitable “Style Barrière” by embarking on a long collaboration with the decorator Jacques Garcia. Under her aegis, the Group acquired the prestigious Fouquet’s brasserie on the Champs-Élysées in Paris in 1998. Boldness, the French art de vivre, refinement and the avant-garde would guide its legacy within the group.

Together, Joy Desseigne-Barrière and Alexandre Barrière constitute the fourth generation of entrepreneurs at the helm of the Group. Passed down from their mother, they ensure its influence, its development, its loyalty to the values that have been its strength since 1912. In 2023, the Group once again became a 100% family business, with Joy and Alexandre as the main shareholders.


SAINT-MALO
