

## **Family: Over 15,000 Registrations for "Adolescence", Fondazione Oltre's Project for Today's Parents and Educators**

- The initiative will consist of four public evenings with leading education experts;
- The events will be broadcast through the "Adolescence Live" podcast;
- The goal is to transform educational responsibilities into opportunities.

**Rome, February 19, 2026** – As the international debate rages on social media and minors' mental health—from UK hearings on TikTok and Instagram addiction to new EU rules to protect adolescents—**Fondazione Oltre**, focused on education, responds with a concrete project: "**Adolescence**", which has already built a thriving community of over fifteen thousand registered participants.

Inspired by Netflix's award-winning series of the same name, the project kicks off tomorrow, February 20, with an encounter featuring **Prof. Alberto Pellai** at Rome's Auditorium Conciliazione.

*"We believe in young people and want to support those who educate them," states Thea Paola Angelini, President of Fondazione Oltre. "Today, the already challenging dialogue between parents and children faces an added challenge: digital languages. Digital natives live through social media, images, and fast codes that remain a mystery to many adults. These are no longer novelties but have changed the way we think, express ourselves, and relate. It's as if parents and kids speak two different languages. This is one of the themes emerging from the TV series 'Adolescence', which leaves viewers deeply unsettled by the issues it highlights, without providing answers. That's why we've designed a journey to address the major educational challenges of our time with realism and responsibility. It won't be a trial of young people or educators, but a shared path to provide families with concrete tools, guidance criteria, and new alliances between the educational world, institutions, and civil society."*

"Adolescence" will unfold over four public evenings at Rome's Auditorium Conciliazione. Each evening will be introduced by **Anna Chiara Gambini**, graphic designer and writer, feature dialogues with guests led by **Gigi De Palo**, Director General of Fondazione Oltre, and conclude with a reflection by **don Fabio Rosini**.

The events will be live-streamed for all project registrants and also distributed via the "Adolescence Live" podcast.
