Program Categories

Where leadership meets purpose.

ANZSOG's Public Leadership Programs equip senior public servants with the insight, confidence and capability to lead with impact. Designed for the realities of government, they strengthen strategic thinking and political astuteness while connecting leaders across jurisdictions to share ideas, challenge assumptions and build lasting networks.



Public Leadership Accelerators

Accelerated, high-impact programs for mid-to-senior public sector leaders seeking rapid capability to uplift and support through strategic transition. Delivered through short, focused learning sprints that enable faster development with minimal time away from your role.

Who are they for?

Mid-to-senior public sector leaders who are high-potential, transitioning into greater scope or complexity and seeking an accelerated alternative to longer-form programs. Designed primarily for EL1-EL2 (or equivalent). Suitable for select high-performing APS6 and SES Band 1 (or equivalent) where there is a specific development need.

Duration

6-12 weeks | 40-100 hours total | 5-8 hours per week.

Public Leadership Credentials

Formal, accredited programs that build deep public leadership capability and deliver recognised qualifications. Designed to support long-term stewardship of public institutions and strengthen system-level capability across the public sector.

Who are they for?

Senior public servants and high-potential leaders seeking rigorous, accredited leadership development to support progression into executive or system-level roles. Primarily EL2-SES Band 1 (or equivalent).

Duration

1-2 years | 5-10 hours per week.

Public Sector Innovation and Dialogue

A dynamic category where public sector leaders engage with fresh insights, courageous conversations, and agile learning. This category of programs foster innovation, supports collaborative problem-solving, and provides a platform to test emerging ideas to shape the future of public sector leadership.

Who are they for?

Emerging & Strategic (+ some Executive) leaders, core and adjacent audiences. (APS6, EL1, EL2).

Duration

5 weeks | 5-10 hours per week.

Public Leadership Intensives

Premium, immersive learning experiences designed for senior public sector executives. Programs in this stream deepen strategic judgment, strengthen the ability to navigate complexity, and support executives to lead systemic change with confidence and resilience. Thus, providing a valuable opportunity to build enduring professional networks across jurisdictions and sectors.

Who are they for?

Senior Executive Service - Executive (+ Apex) leaders. Deputy Secretaries, Commissioners, CEs, Directors-General, Executive Directors, General Managers or Equivalent (SES1, SES2, SES3).

Duration

6-10 weeks | 40-50 hours total | 4-5 days residential.

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Deputies Leadership Program


Applications close 14 Aug 2026


This program offers a clear, grounded understanding of what it means to lead as a Deputy. Blending research-informed insight with the lived experience of senior public leaders, it equips participants to navigate complexity, steward digital transformation, and deliver policy that creates real impact.


Learners gain practical tools they can put to work immediately, build relationships across jurisdictions, and deepen their capability to lead confidently at the political-administrative interface. 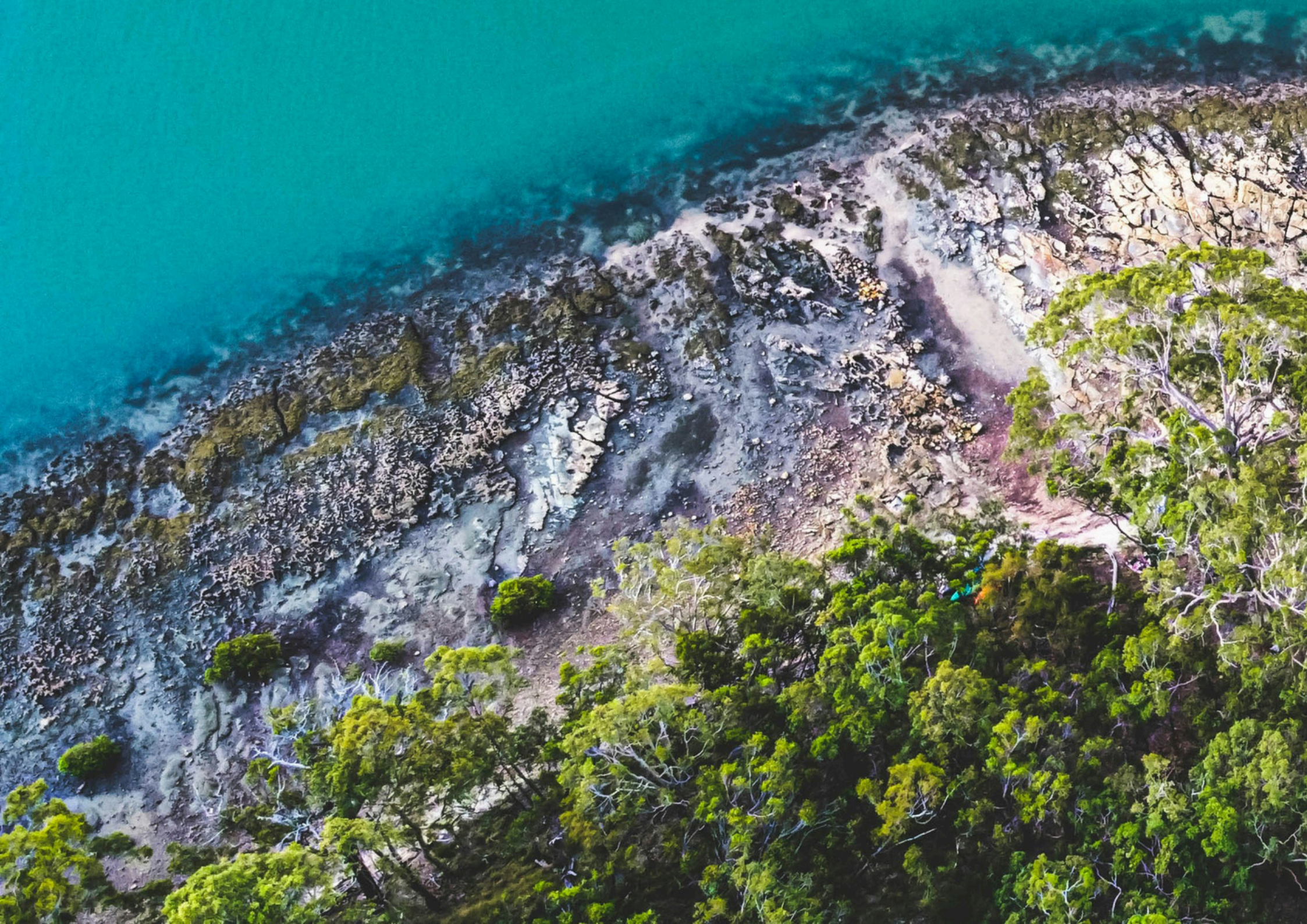
