This Statement is published in accordance with the UK Modern Slavery Act 2015, the Australian Modern Slavery Act 2018, and Canada's Fighting Against Forced Labour and Child Labour in Supply Chains Act 2023. It has been approved by the Executive Committee of mylife Diabetes Care AG and is made on behalf of mylife Diabetes Care Ltd (UK), mylife Diabetes Care Australia Pty Ltd, and mylife Diabetes Care Canada Inc.

About mylife Diabetes Care

Headquartered in Burgdorf, Switzerland, mylife Diabetes Care develops patient-centred solutions to improve life with diabetes. As a leader in automated insulin delivery, we focus on innovation, digital empowerment, customer excellence, and broadening access to diabetes care. mylife Diabetes Care AG, organised under Swiss law, owns and manages the global mylife Diabetes Care Group and procures goods and services through an international network of partners. As part of this global supply chain, we recognise the risks of modern slavery and are committed to applying the highest ethical standards throughout our operations.

Employees

As of 31 March 2026, mylife Group has approximately 800 employees worldwide. We maintain safe and healthy working environments through robust safety systems, inspections, and supportive workplace programmes. Our culture is built on flexibility, work-life balance, fair working conditions and equal opportunities, including flexible working hours, part-time options, and parental leave. Diversity and inclusion remain essential pillars of our company identity, as emphasised in mylife's Code of Ethics.

Suppliers

Integrity across the supply chain is fundamental to our operations. Through our policies and the mylife Partners Code of Ethics - aligned with ILO conventions, OECD Guidelines, and UN Global Compact principles - we require all partners to respect human rights, prohibit forced and child labour, ensure fair working conditions, and comply with all applicable laws. We only engage suppliers that formally commit to these standards.

Due Diligence and Risk assessment

To identify risks of non-compliance, mylife Group conducts due diligence on critical suppliers, including through a third-party supply chain questionnaire. mylife Diabetes Care Group's suppliers are subject to a systematic, data-based risk assessment. mylife's Procurement department works closely with qualified and high-performing partners across the value chain to create the best possible value for our customers. We believe in trust, innovation, and long-term partnerships. Compliance with mylife's Code of Ethics throughout the entire supply chain is essential. To ensure the high quality of our products, critical suppliers are subject to targeted, risk-based checks and audits. Factors such as human rights, child labour, anti-corruption measures and environmental protection are taken into account in this process.

mylife Diabetes Care fulfils its due diligence and transparency obligations with regard to minerals and metals from conflict areas and child labour as required by law. Based on our assessment, there is no reasonable suspicion that mylife Diabetes Care's suppliers provide products and services using child labour.

Policies

mylife Diabetes Care is committed to protecting human rights and strictly prohibits modern slavery and human trafficking. Our Code of Ethics outlines our commitment to preventing, mitigating and addressing any adverse human rights impacts within our workplace, business operations and the community we serve.

All employees and entities must follow our internal policies, processes, and our Code of Ethics, which define expected conduct across our business.

Training

Ongoing training is essential to maintaining ethical and compliant behaviour. All employees receive regular training on our Code of Ethics, including topics such as interactions with healthcare professionals, conflicts of interest, anti-corruption, harassment, discrimination, data protection, and use of the whistleblowing system. We continue to strengthen awareness and promote responsible behaviour across the organisation.
